You will only have to intervene if your cat is struggling to cough up the hairball. In this instance, you should bring your cat to the veterinarian and have them clear the hairball.

You can buy gels that will help your cat bring up hairballs much easier. The gel will coat their digestive tract making it much easier for the hairball to pass through.
