

Park Meeting Minutes May 11, 2026

Old Business:

1. Review of 12/15/25 minutes. Lee motion to approve, Lori 2nd, unanimous approval.
2. Review of 2/9/26 minutes. Lori motion to approve, Jim 2nd, unanimous approval.
3. Review of 3/9/26 minutes. Lee motion to approve, Jim 2nd, unanimous approval.
4. New Business' item #3 (2/9/26minutes)– development of DNR Marine Safety grant – incomplete. Timeframe lapsed.
5. New Business item #3 (3/9/26) – Lori will check with Amy about printing and binding of approved Rec Plan – either print in office with binders if possible or seek Township funds to have plan printed and bound. Need approximately 10 copies: one for formal Minutes, one for each Committee member, one held in Township office, with 3-4 for possible grant filings.
6. Resignation of Heidi Murdoch from the Parks and Rec Committee was formally submitted to and approved by the Township Board.

New Business:

1. Discussion about 4th of July possible fundraising activities. A proposed community yard sale event for the 4th was discussed. We agreed to the following:
 - a. The sale would occur at the park pavilion on the 4th from 9am-2pm.
 - b. Donations would be accepted at the site on the 3rd from 3-7pm and on the 4th from 7-8:30 am.
 - c. Cindy and Lee will begin advertising event on Facebook accounts. Cindy will meet with Jill at Sugar Daddy's about inclusion of the event in the listing of 4th of July activities. Lori and Jim will produce signage and flyers.
 - d. Jim will see about procuring additional tables. Cindy will obtain labelling for items. Lori will obtain start-up cash.
2. Lori handed out information about obtaining 501(c)(3) status for the Parks committee. All to review and discuss next meeting.
3. All need to attend next Township Board meeting to emphasize the need for at least one porta-potty for the Park over the summer for all events.
