COMPETITION RULES

1.	The eligible species is Snapper and Gummy Shark only, capture/release is restricted to waters reached from Port Welshpool - Including Corner Inlet and adjacent offshore waters.
2.	The competition begins Friday 14th November 2025 6:00am - Ends at 3:00pm Saturday 22nd November 2025. All entries are to be submitted and entry fee payments made prior to fishing.
3.	Entries are online, either through the TMF App or the South Gippsland Game Fishing Club website. To enter download the TMF (track my Fish) App and follow the prompts. Entries receive a complimentary 'Snapper + Gummy Challenge' Brag Mat & Fishing shirt
4.	Minimum size of fish accepted is as per the current Victorian recreational fishing guide. Bag Limits per species apply as per Victorian recreational fishing guide.
5.	Fish MUST be measured on the OFFICIAL brag mat provided to competitors by SGGFC. All fish must be measured as per Victorian Recreational fishing guidelines. For this competition Snapper are to be measured from the noise to the fork in the tail. Gummies are to be measured from the Noise to the base of the tail. Photo's to be taken on a flat brag mat showing the whole fish & then downloaded to the TMF App. Anglers are advised to have their location on & save the photo to their gallery in case of a dispute a member of SGGFC may need proof of capture. It is recommended that anglers take multiple photos of their fish in case of a dispute. All photos must clearly show the fish's nose against the "0" board of the mat. The brag mat must be perfectly flat and clean, failure to comply may result in the fish being disqualified. In the event of a tie, the fish entered first on TMF will be considered the winner. NO MUTILATED FISH IN PHOTO,S WILL BE ACCEPTED
6.	All photo's must be received prior to 3:00pm Saturday November 22nd, no exceptions. Presentations will follow the event at 5.30pm.
7.	The SGGFC Event organizing Committee reserves the right, without reason to refuse any application for entry.
8.	By entering the competition, all competitors acknowledge that they give the SGGFC Event organizing Committee the right to use all; or any photos or video taken during the competition for promotional or advertising purposes.
9.	The sole adjudicator on all matters shall be the SGGFC Event organizing Committee. All decisions are final no further discussions or correspondence will be entertained.
10.	The SGGFC Event organizing Committee reserves the right, without reason to cancel the competition at any time. All participants will be entitled to a full refund subject to event cancellation, (Weather affected) At the SGGFC's earliest convenience.
11.	Disputes and challenges will only be considered by the SGGFC Event Organizer's if made in writing providing all relevant facts are presented to the organizing committee no later than 15 minutes after the close of fishing on Saturday November 22nd. Disputes and challenges will not be accepted once the presentation of prizes commences. Any person found to be in breach of these rules or conditions of entry shall be subject to disqualification from the competition and any prizes involved.
12.	This competition encourages all attempts by anglers to "catch and release" where possible. It is recommended that 'non-leader board' fish be considered for release throughout competition. We also recognize the right of Competitors to take fish within the bag limits set by Victorian fisheries.
