Introduction

As we embark on this sacred journey, our focus will be on seeking the Lord's presence, empowerment, and direction through prayer, fasting, and the study of His Word in Acts chapters 1-3. These passages reveal the foundations of the Church, the outpouring of the Holy Spirit, and the boldness of early believers. Let us commit our hearts to God, expecting renewal, revelation, and revival.



GUIDELINES FOR FASTING

Choose one or combine:

1. Liquid Fast: Consume only liquids (water, herbal teas, smoothies, juices, broths).
2. One Meal a Day Fast: Eat one simple meal daily after 6:00 PM.
3. Media Fast: Abstain from non-essential media and entertainment.

Consult your physician before fasting, especially if you have health concerns.

The following are different ways to fast as you anoint yourself with Holy Anointing Oil, soaked in prayer, and made specifically for Nexus Community Church according to Exodus 30:22-30. As you prepare to meet with God ask Him which sacrifice you are required to make. If He asks, are you willing to give up coffee, sweets, lunch, television, or internet games during this time to achieve intimacy with God, spiritual clarity and power to carry out your Kingdom assignments? During this time of consecration make sure you are utilizing your spiritual technologies.

One Meal A Day Fast:

This meal should be kept simple. Remember to hydrate with plenty of water and fluids during the day. We will fast from 6:00am – 6:00pm with one meal after 6:00pm

Liquid Fast:

In the liquid fast, there is no intake of solid foods. All food is replaced with liquids. Liquids can be consumed at any time. Make sure that you drink plenty of water, and you may also include fruit juices, vegetable juices, herbal teas, smoothies, soups and broth.

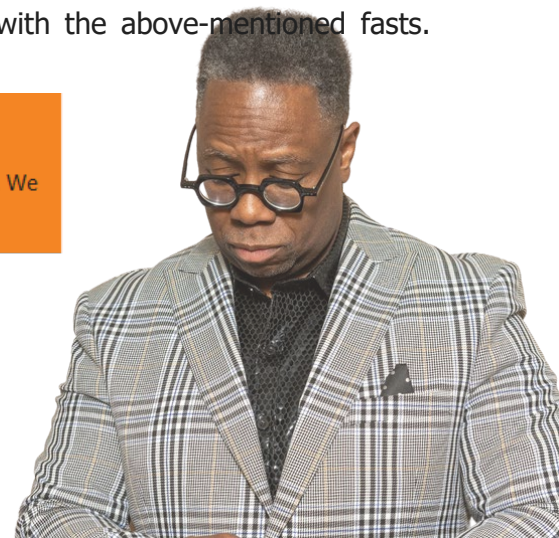
Media/Social Media Fast:

For this fast, we abstain from anything that would personally distract us from drawing closer to God. While media may be accessed when necessary for safety and pertinent information, restrictions include, but are not limited to: watching television for pleasure, idle use of social media outlets, playing video games, unnecessary texting, video chats, phone conversations, etc.

This type of fast is suggested for those who have physical issues that prohibit them from engaging in food restrictions. However, it is also recommended to be done in conjunction with the above-mentioned fasts.

WEAPONS OF WARFARE

2 Corinthians 10:4-5

4 For the weapons of our warfare [are] not carnal but mighty in God for pulling down strongholds, 5 casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ,

THE NAME: There is authority in the name of Jesus.

PRAYER: Father, according to your Word in Isaiah 54:17, I believe that no weapon formed against me will succeed. So, I affirm today and in the future, in the name of Jesus, that no weapon formed against me will ever prosper. Your Word also assures in Nahum 1:9 that trouble will not arise a second time. Therefore, I declare in Jesus' name that Satan will not bring trouble to me again, just as he did in the past.

I proclaim that all of these prayers are fulfilled and realized through my unwavering faith and expectation in you, in the mighty name of Jesus.



WEAPONS OF WARFARE

[Revelations 12:11 11 "And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony, and they did not love their lives to the death.

THE BLOOD: The shedding of Jesus' blood represents the ultimate victory over the adversary.

PRAYER: Dear Lord Jesus, I humbly ask for forgiveness and turn away from both the sins I am aware of and those I may not even realize, whether they were actions I took or things I neglected to do. I openly admit to You all my wrongdoings from today, yesterday, and every day that has passed. I surrender to You all the sins related to my actions, words, and thoughts, as well as any impure intentions and behaviors. I am truly grateful, Lord, for the sacrifice of Your precious blood on my behalf.



WEAPONS OF WARFARE

[Matthew 4:10-11 10 Then Jesus said to him, "Away with you, Satan! For it is written, 'You shall worship the LORD your God, and Him only you shall serve.' " 11 Then the devil left Him, and behold, angels came and ministered to Him.

THE WORD: The Word of God holds significant power.

PRAYER: For it is written that man does not solely rely on nourishment of the body but on every utterance that emanates from the mouth of God. I firmly anchor myself in Your teachings. Adversity is expelled from all directions: ahead of me, above me, around me, and below me; from my dwelling, my workplace, my place of worship and its various ministries; from my offspring and/or cherished ones; from my ventures, land, and my very presence. I affirm that the enemy is powerless against me, and his malevolent deeds are held captive and eradicated. No weapons devised against me shall succeed, for the Spirit of the Lord will establish a barrier against them. I proclaim the realization of all these things through Your Word.

Jesus, my Savior, I offer You gratitude, adoration, exaltation, reverence, and devotion for the righteousness and sanctity bestowed upon me through Your Word in my name.

3 DAYS OF CONSECRATION WHAT IS A COVENANT?

A covenant is an agreement between God and his people, in which God makes promises to his people and, usually, requires certain conduct from them. The Bible has covenants between man and man and GOD and man. A covenant might be conditional or unconditional. The Mosaic Covenant was conditional. Exodus 19:5 5 'Now therefore, if you will indeed obey My voice and keep My covenant, then you shall be a special treasure to Me above all people; for all the earth [is] Mine. The 'if' made it conditional. This means the children of Israel had a role to play in this covenant.

Covenants often accompanied by oaths, signs, and ceremonies. They define obligations and commitments, but they are different from a contract because they are relational and personal.
