

# The Christian Bill of Rights

1. You have the right to a healed body.

## Isaiah 53:5 (NKJV)

<sup>5</sup>But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; The chastisement for our peace was upon Him, And by His stripes we are healed.

2. You have the right to a sound mind.

#### 2 Timothy 1:7 (NKJV)

<sup>7</sup>For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind.

3. You have the right to have your needs met.

## Philippians 4:19 (NKJV)

<sup>19</sup>And my God shall supply all your need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus.

4. You have the right to peace.

# John 14:27 (NKJV)

<sup>27</sup>Peace I leave with you, My peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.

5. You have the right to a happy home/family.

# Psalm 112:2–3 (NKJV)

<sup>2</sup>His descendants will be mighty on earth; The generation of the upright will be blessed. <sup>3</sup>Wealth and riches will be in his house, And his righteousness endures forever.

6. You have the right to saved children.

#### Isaiah 54:13 (NLT)

13| will teach all your children, and they will enjoy great peace.



7. You have the right to have your prayers answered.

#### 1 John 5:14 (NLT)

<sup>14</sup>And we are confident that he hears us whenever we ask for anything that pleases him.

8. You have the right to live without fear.

# John 16:33 (NLT)

<sup>33</sup>I have told you all this so that you may have peace in me. Here on earth you will have many trials and sorrows. But take heart, because I have overcome the world."

9. You have the right to dignity and respect.

#### Psalm 139:14 (NKJV)

14 will praise You, for I am fearfully *and* wonderfully made; Marvelous are Your works, And *that* my soul knows very well.

10. You have the right to protection.

## Isaiah 54:17 (NKJV)

<sup>17</sup>No weapon formed against you shall prosper, And every tongue which rises against you in judgment You shall condemn. This is the heritage of the servants of the Lord, And their righteousness is from Me," Says the Lord.

# Isaiah 54:17 (NLT)

<sup>17</sup>But in that coming day no weapon turned against you will succeed. You will silence every voice raised up to accuse you. These benefits are enjoyed by the servants of the Lord; their vindication will come from me. I, the Lord, have spoken!

11. You have the right to be called righteous

#### Romans 5:17 (NLT)

<sup>17</sup>For the sin of this one man, Adam, caused death to rule over many. But even greater is God's wonderful grace and his gift of righteousness, for all who receive it will live in triumph over sin and death through this one man, Jesus Christ.



12. You have the right to be forgiven.

## 1 John 1:9 (NLT)

<sup>9</sup>But if we confess our sins to him, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all wickedness.

13. You have the right to eternal and heavenly life.

#### John 11:26 (NLT)

<sup>26</sup>Everyone who lives in me and believes in me will never ever die. Do you believe this, Martha?"

14. You have the right to be on the top.

## Deuteronomy 28:13 (NKJV)

<sup>13</sup>And the Lord will make you the head and not the tail; you shall be above only, and not be beneath, if you heed the commandments of the Lord your God, which I command you today, and are careful to observe *them*.

15. You have the right to be free.

# 2 Corinthians 3:17 (NLT)

<sup>17</sup>For the Lord is the Spirit, and wherever the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom.
