Welcome to an exciting new school year at Academy of Dover! In preparation for school opening, we are providing the following information to you. The first day of school is August 22, 2019; beginning at 8:00 a.m. *Please be aware that the school day begins at 8:00 a.m.

1. Students must wear school uniforms, which is as follows:

TOPS

White, Light Blue, Navy Blue shirt with collar; shirts must be tucked into bottoms and worn at the waistline at all times.

Undershirts, turtlenecks and tank tops are permitted, must be solid blue, white or black

Solid blue cardigans sweaters can be worn over required shirts. Sweat shirts and hoodies are not permitted. **BOTTOMS**

Navy Blue or Khaki slacks, knee-length skirts or skorts, jumpers, shorts, (cargo shorts are not permitted). Denim, Leggings, Jeggings are NOT permitted.

SHOES/SOCKS

Any school appropriate shoe may be worn. High heels or open toe or open heel shoes are not permitted due to safety reasons.

Pants cannot be tucked into footwear unless it inclement weather.

Solid Navy Blue, White, Black socks, tights; Socks or tights with bold colors stripes and designs are NOT permitted.

***P.E. day's students may wear blue sweatpants with white, light blue or navy collar shirt.

- Transportation is provided to students in grades K-5 who reside within the schools transportation
 parameters. If you have any questions pertaining to transportation eligibility, please contact Transportation
 Supervisor.
- 3. The Academy of Dover Charter School contracts with private contractors, so transportation routes are longer than those of traditional school districts.
- 4. Parents are requested to walk the route to the bus stop with your child and remain with the child until the bus arrives. Parents are directly responsible for the conduct of the child until the child boards the school bus. An adult must be present at bus stop to get Kindergarten students off the bus.
- 5. Buses will drop students off at the front of the building. Cars must drop students off at the rear of the building. Students can be dropped off beginning at 7:45 a.m. Students will not be able to enter building before 7:45 a.m., unless student is being dropped off to <u>Boys & Girls Club Before-Care</u>. Dismissal is at 3:15 p.m. All students not participating in after school activities must be picked up by 3:15 p.m. at the rear of the building.
- 6. We would like students to be prepared with the basic school supplies such as pencils, crayons and paper for the first few days of school. Other supplies can be brought within the first couple of weeks.
- 7. Students are provided with small cubbies for keeping personal items.
- 8. School begins at 8:00 a.m.; students arriving to school after 8:15 a.m. are considered Tardy and <u>must be</u> signed into school by an adult 18 years or older.
