Founder/Director Story

I started this organization over 5 years ago, because my family and I were once homeless in Arkansas. We were having to live everyday not knowing if we were going to have any food or a place to sleep for months. One day God sent us the help we needed. We started going to a church where we found HOPE again. My husband was introduced to someone who actually changed our lives forever by giving him a job with a company that he is with to this day. This allowed us to get an apartment and slowly get back on our feet. Through his job we were asked if we wanted to move to Texas and with alot of prayer we said yes. After being here for a few months I wanted to give back, so I started Blessing Bags. I wanted to help others in Nacogdoches and Angelina Counties who are homeless and struggling with toiletry products, food, summer/winter essentials and with resources they may need.
