It is not ours by way of inheritance; it must be fought for and defended constantly by each generation.” Whether you believe it or not, this was from Ronald Reagan's commencement speech when he became governor of California.

And now for our message. At times we may come off as a partisan group, but this is not the case, and we will not apologize for calling out any group or party who fails to defend democracy and the constitution.

This week I want to touch on how hyperpartisanship is a threat to democracy. Hyperpartisanship occurs when politicians put the desires of their party ahead of the needs of the country and their constituents. When this happens, legislative compromise and mutual tolerance is replaced with a sensationalized and toxic "us versus them" mentality.

Hyperpartisanship is further amplified by social media algorithms which reward highly partisan or sensational content. Users are funneled into information silos, limiting exposure to alternative viewpoints. But we do have a choice of whether we allow this to continue.

So what is the solution?

At the heart of democracy there must be compromise, and party labels must be less relevant than the principles of democracy and the good of the people. This requires talking to each other, listening to each other and trying to find common ground with our neighbors. It means limiting our exposure to the bombardment of filtered content which only fans the flames of polarization and seeking more balanced and neutral sources of news.

There will always be those among us whose values and ideologies are so vastly different from ours that there is no shot at setting these things aside. It is my belief these people are the minority. It is the majority of us that make up “We the People” and we must stand together if we are to thrive as a nation. United we stand and divided we fall. This must be our motto.

This Week's Tasks

[TRUMP'S CRIMINAL REIGN MUST END](#) - When a president makes essential government functions conditional on specific legislative demands, it undermines the separation of powers. This is an impeachable act and considered to fit within the definition of "High Crimes and Misdemeanors". Trump has refused to sign the 21st Century ROAD to Housing Act, a bipartisan bill, until the SAVE Act in some form is passed. This is unconstitutional and just another way in which Trump is illegally wielding power in an attempt to disrupt any democratic process which might unseat him and his cronies. It is time we demand Congress do their job and hold him accountable, and not let up until they do.

[STAND AGAINST THE SAVE ACT IN ANY FORM](#) – A strong coalition of both Democratic and key Republican lawmakers has stood firm against passing the SAVE America Act. In response, Trump says he will refuse to sign any other legislation into law until Congress passes the SAVE America Act. Proving citizenship can be a significant challenge for millions of eligible U.S. voters. When Kansas implemented a strict proof-of-citizenship requirement, it blocked the registrations of more than 30,000 valid U.S. citizens (12% of all new applicants) while only 39 voters were registered improperly. The courts eventually struck down the law. There is no upside to the SAVE Act and there is the potential to disenfranchise millions. Your voice is needed to ensure this never becomes law.

[OPPOSE TODD BLANCHE'S APPOINTMENT TO U.S. ATTORNEY GENERAL](#) – Todd Blanche is unfit to serve as the U.S. Attorney General. He has prioritized his loyalty to Trump and the Republican party over the rule of law, granted sweeping criminal and civil protection to the President and his associates including from IRS audits, aggressively used DOJ resources to pursue investigations against the President's political adversaries and attempted to orchestrate a nearly \$1.8 billion payout fund, potentially to reward insurrectionists. His confirmation hearing is scheduled for July 15th, so now is the time to let your senators know where you stand.

[BLOCK THE INTEGRATION OF THE US AND ISRAELI MILITARIES](#) – Allowing this deep fusion would erode US foreign policy autonomy, bypass essential congressional oversight on military aid, and could pull U.S. the into conflicts instigated by Israel. Keeping these systems separate preserves national sovereignty and maintains accountability over shared defense and AI technologies. Currently, some of the congresspeople who originally stood against this move are now supporting this legislation, and without your voice, it may pass. Let your congresspeople know where you stand.

[REFORM THE SUPREME COURT](#) – Explosive reports of justices accepting luxury travel, vacations, and real estate transactions from billionaire benefactors have sparked major outcries, and yet the public has no mechanism to overturn a Supreme Court ruling or force a justice to

resign. Power corrupts and absolute power corrupts absolutely. The SCERT Act would establish a binding and enforceable code of ethics and the ROBE Act would establish term limits. Together these would help re-shape the court for the benefit of us, the people. Use your voice to make sure this subject remains relevant until the court is reformed.

Thank you for being an active member in our growing community, and for all your efforts to help make a difference. It is people like you engaging and staying the course that give us all hope, and our combined efforts are beginning to see big payoffs!
