I hope all of you had a wonderful Independence Day weekend. My family and I celebrated with a diverse crowd of proud Americans. There was no mention of political parties or threats from within. The only political discussion of note mentioned the lack of divisiveness. It was beautiful! Unfortunately, this was not the case in other celebrations.

While the 250th celebration on the National Mall was meant to celebrate how our forefathers forged an enduring union, Trump and the Freedom 250 organization hijacked Washington's events for a partisan campaign rally. Instead of promoting unity, Trump used this opportunity to target political rivals and labeled all who stood against him as "hardcore, godless communists" who were a "cancer" and a "mortal threat to American liberty".

Unlike other presidents of the past who used July 4th as an opportunity to promote unity, Trump promoted a toxic “us versus them” mentality. He knows full well this divisive rhetoric directly undermines our democratic values, fracturing the nation in a moment where Americans normally stand closer together. But that is his plan. Thankfully, more Americans are waking up to this intentional effort to divide us.

As you know, the Freedom 250 Great American State Fair was plagued by sparse crowds and lower-than-anticipated attendance. Many performers also withdrew from this event, and at least 10 states formally declined to send official government delegations or host a booth. If that does not speak to the unfortunate result of these divisive efforts, I do not know what does. And although I am sad to see what we have come to, this is also a sign of hope and progress.

Last week I talked about hyperpartisanship, and how this polarization only grows divides. This is pertinent because our response to these events can help us build unity or widen divides. We need to capitalize on the waning support Trump and his allies are experiencing.

Therefore, it is in times like these that we must strategically carry ourselves with class and grace. With support shifting, our focus must be on welcoming new voices and changed minds with dignity, rather than trading political blows and maintaining the “us versus them” culture Trump wants.

[**SUPPORT THE WE THE PEOPLE AMENDMENT & THE MONTANA PLAN**](#) – Supporting both the We the People Amendment and the Montana Plan offers a powerful dual-track strategy to eliminate dark money and corporate dominance in American elections by attacking the Citizens United ruling from entirely different angles. Overall, by stripping corporations of human rights and declaring that money is not protected speech, these efforts aim to rescue democracy from the grip of wealthy special interests and dark money. Ultimately, this is about reclaiming sovereign power for living citizens, ensuring our government is accountable to the people rather than the highest bidder. [**URGE CONGRESS TO SUPPORT THE "BY THE PEOPLE" AMENDMENT**](#) - Currently, congresspeople (U.S. Representatives and Senators) can only be removed from office prior to the end of their term by their peers and only with a 2/3 supermajority vote. A president or vice-president can only be removed if first charged by the House with a crime followed by the Senate convicting them with a 2/3 supermajority vote. No proposal is currently active or advancing that grants citizens the direct legal power to impeach the president or congresspeople. Worse yet, there are a group of conservatives looking to remove the power of the people to elect their own senators. This task asks you to urge congress to support an amendment to the constitution that would empower citizens to recall congresspeople, presidents and/or vice-presidents. [**REFORM THE SUPREME COURT**](#) – Explosive reports of justices accepting luxury travel, vacations, and real estate transactions from billionaire benefactors have sparked major outcries, and yet the public has no mechanism to overturn a Supreme Court ruling or force a justice to resign. Power corrupts and absolute power corrupts absolutely. The SCERT Act would establish a binding and enforceable code of ethics and the ROBE Act would establish term limits. Together these would help re-shape the court for the benefit of us, the people. Use your voice to make sure this subject remains relevant until the court is reformed. [**TRUMP'S CRIMINAL REIGN MUST END**](#) - When a president makes essential government functions conditional on specific legislative demands, it undermines the separation of powers.

This is an impeachable act and considered to fit within the definition of "High Crimes and Misdemeanors". Trump has refused to sign the 21st Century ROAD to Housing Act, a bipartisan bill, until the SAVE Act in some form is passed. This is unconstitutional and just another way in which Trump is illegally wielding power in an attempt to disrupt any democratic process which might unseat him and his cronies. [OPPOSE TODD BLANCHE'S APPOINTMENT TO U.S. ATTORNEY GENERAL](#) – Todd Blanche is unfit to serve as the U.S. Attorney General.
