November Highlights

Holy Eucharist Rite II each Sunday at 10 a.m. with guitar and/or clarinet the first and third Sundays, and organ the second and fourth.

Saturday, November 6 - Fall Back!
Daylight Savings Time ends.

Sunday, November 7 - All Saints Day Observance - Holy Eucharist II and Renewal of Baptismal Vows

The liturgical calendar allows for All Saints to be celebrated the first Sunday after November 1. We'll renew our baptismal vows and celebrate the saints who came before. There will be fine music, including a childhood favorite as well as one that includes this line:

*Let saints on earth in concert sing
with those whose work is done
Come celebrate!*

Sunday, November 14 - Vestry meets (a week early this month) following coffee hour. Everyone welcome.

Sunday, November 21 - The Last Sunday of Pentecost - Christ the King. We end the church year on this day, which is marked by themes of Christ's kingship. We move from Lectionary Year B to C and begin the new year:

Advent begins November 28. We missed gathering to observe this season of quiet preparation last year due to Covid. It will be wonderful to begin the new church year together with our beautiful Advent Wreath and



the Carol Reed Memorial Mitten Tree, which this year we will fill with socks for all ages.



Looking ahead to Christmas - We were very pleased with our Christmas video for 2020, but it wasn't the same as actually worshipping together. Christmas falls on a Saturday this year, which could mean for a really busy weekend at Trinity. Begin thinking about what musical gift you might want to offer on Christmas Eve. Not musical? Then you are cordially invited to join in a brass polishing party, date to be determined.

Covid - Our area has many infections. You are strongly encouraged (but not required) to wear a mask in church and to remain safely distanced. And get your booster - most of us are eligible.

Music - The vestry is beginning the process of seeking a replacement organist. We love Paula, but she didn't sign up for long term and none of our own musicians can play keyboard. Do you have someone to suggest?
