February Highlights

Worship each Sunday at 10 a.m. is Holy Eucharist Rite II with guitar and/or clarinet the first and third Sundays, and organ the second and fourth.



Sunday, February 13 -Souper Bowl Sunday - Place a dollar, or

more, in the soup pot by the baptismal font for each member of your family - you can include all the relatives and pets, too, if you wish. This national event takes place every year on Super Bowl Sunday. All funds are donated to local food pantries.

Sunday, February 20th - Vestry meets following coffee hour. Everyone is welcome to attend.

Sunday, February 27 - The Last Sunday After the Epiphany, also known as *Alleluia Sunday*. We

used to "hide" the Alleluia when our church school was active as an illustration that there are no alleluias spoken during Lent. We'll be singing all the Alleluia hymns, so be sure to sing with gusto!

Shrove Tuesday pancake supper? As we get closer to the end of the month we'll need to see how the Covid infection rates are (they're very bad now, see below) and decide if we're going to have our annual pancake supper for Fat Tuesday/Mardi Gras. If we do, it will be March 1 at 6.

Safely worshiping - an update: Bradford County, with just a 42% vaccination rate, is very high risk, with 199 new cases today (1/29). Most of you are fully vaccinated (boosted), but Omicron (BA-1) is highly contagious and breakthrough infections can happen. There is also a new variant, BA-2, which is even more contagious. The vestry asks that you wear a mask

and socially distance at worship.

180th Annual Meeting - as of press time, the meeting will take place tomorrow after worship. We begin with a potluck brunch, always delicious, then review the past year and plan for 2022. Yes, it's brutally cold, but please plan to attend - the buildings and the people will give you warmth! Please consider serving on the vestry - it's a once-amonth commitment, meetings are short, and everything is done by consensus. Your presence will enrich all of us.
