November Highlights

Sunday worship is at 10 a.m. followed by coffee hour at 11. Please be silent after the bell rings before worship begins.

Saturday, November 2 - Institution of The Rt. Rev. Sean T. Rowe as 28th Presiding Bishop. Chapel of Christ the Lord, Episcopal Church Center, New York City. Traditionally, it was held at The National Cathedral; this event will make a smaller carbon footprint and simplify the process. It begins at 9:30 with the rollcall of the dioceses; the service is at 11 a.m. It will be available to view at any time afterward.

Sunday, November 3 - All Saints Sunday - Holy Eucharist II and Renewal of Baptismal Vows.

Sunday, November 24 - Last Pentecost - Christ the King. This is the last Sunday of the church year as well. In December we begin a new year with the season of Advent, a time of quiet preparation. Also - **Vestry Meets**
