

Texas is **3rd** in the nation
for citrus production

Citrus growth comprises of
almost 27,000 acres across a
three-county area in the Lower Rio
Grande Valley.

Together, Texas growers produce
more than **9 million** cartons of
fresh grapefruit and oranges each
year and another **5 million** cartons
of juice fruit valued at over **\$100
million dollars**.



An estimated 1 million peach trees are planted
statewide, only half of which are planted in
commercial orchards of 1 acre or larger.

BEARS ITS SEEDS ON THE OUTSIDE




THE GROCERY STORE.




On average, one farmer
