## NEWSLETTER.

Dear Former Member MCB-2:

If you attended the first MCB-2 reunion in 1991 you know that we will have another reunion in 1993 and that a Committee was selected to decide on the place and time for that reunion. The selection of place and time was narrowed to two locations, Nashville or Las Vegas, and to either May or September.

A questionnaire was sent out to each of you whose address was known and your preference for place and month was requested. We received 130 replies. Some of the replies indicated that there was no preference, either place and either month would be equally satisfactory. Of those who indicated a preference 58% voted for Nashville and 78% voted for September.

On August 22 your 1993 Reunion Committee met in Nashville. Seven members of the Committee were able to attend. Travel and lodging were at their own personal expense so organizational funds were not tapped. After carefully reviewing what was available we decided that the best facilities by far were those that the Marriott Hotel could provide.

The Marriott is a very pleasant hotel, convenient to the airport and to Opryland U.S.A. The normal price for a double room runs between \$ 117 and \$ 140 per day plus tax. We negotiated a price of \$ 69 per day plus tax, which price will be good not only during the time of the reunion but for 3 days before and 3 days after the reunion. A block of 150 rooms are being reserved for us; however, you are not locked into the Marriott when you attend the reunion. There are several good hotels in the \$ 35 to \$ 50 range located nearby from which it would be convenient to attend functions at the Marriott if you have transportation.

The 1993 MCB-2 Reunion at the Marriott is scheduled for 16,17 and 18 September. You will receive, at a later date, more detailed information about agenda, costs, hotels and what to see and do in Nashville.

There is something that we would like you to do now in order to help us in our planning. We would be most appreciative if you would cut off the survey form at the bottom of this letter, fill it out and mail it to us without delay. By filling it out you are not committing yourself to anything. We would like to know if it is your intention to attend the Reunion, provided health and finances allow and the creek doesn't rise. By the same token, if you know that you will not be able to attend please tell us.

If you attended our first reunion, you had a great time. Your Committee intends for you to have as good a time at the 1993 Reunion. If you were unable to attend the first reunion you don't want to miss this second reunion. Your friends are looking forward to renewing their friendship and swapping some yarns with you.
