

More: Do you remember>>>> *December 31st 1946 was the official end of WW II and the end of the Kosovo Campaign 2013.

* After the American War for independence, Congress sold its surviving ships of the Continental Navy and released the seamen and Officers. The constitution of the US ratified in 1789, empowered Congress "To provide & maintain a navy." Congress ordered the construction and manning of 6 frigates in 1794. It was the Navy League that sponsored the first national observance of Navy Day in 1922. In 1972 the Chief of Naval **Operations Admiral E. R. Zumwalt** authorized recognition of October 13th as the Navy's Birthday.
