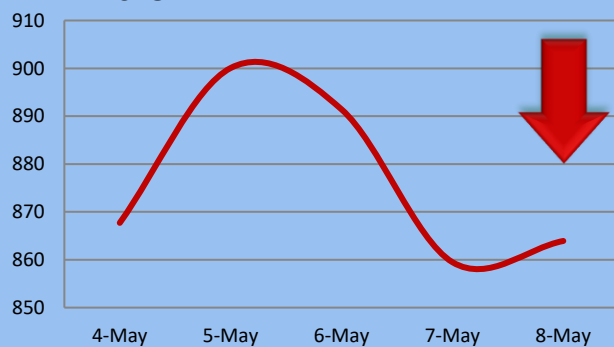

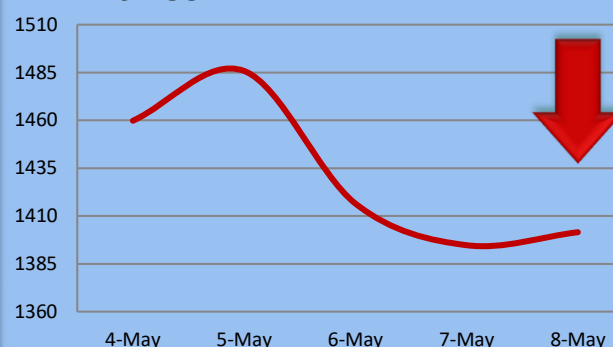
Top stories of the week

➤ CMA CGM confirmed that its container ship CMA CGM San Antonio was damaged in an Iranian attack while transiting the Strait of Hormuz on Tuesday, with several crew members injured and later evacuated for medical treatment. The UK Maritime Trade Operations had earlier reported a cargo ship struck by projectiles at 18:30 UTC, just hours before President Donald Trump announced a temporary pause to Project Freedom, the US operation assisting vessels through the strait, after which no further attacks occurred there. However, tensions reignited Thursday when US and Iranian forces exchanged fire in the strait, with Trump stating three US destroyers transited "under fire" and destroyed Iranian missiles, drones, and small boats before rejoining the naval blockade. Crude futures climbed Friday morning, with ICE July Brent reaching \$101.22 per barrel, up \$1.16 from Thursday's settlement, amid fears of a collapsing ceasefire. The UAE also issued a national missile threat alert Friday as its air defenses intercepted Iranian ballistic missiles, cruise missiles, and drones. Separately, Iranian forces seized the Barbados-flagged tanker Ocean Koi in the Sea of Oman, a vessel previously sanctioned by US OFAC in February 2026 for transporting Iranian high sulfur fuel oil since 2020.
