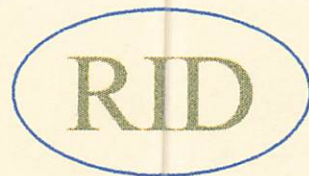

Events would include putting wilderness golf shooting (air rifle) volley ball mini digger operating prowess and tractor pull/tug of war.


