Coaching Conduct and Guidelines

COACHES CONDUCT

1. Spring Grove Area School District policy will be in affect during practices, league matches, and during tournaments or any other function that requires the use of school district property.
2. Respect for wrestlers, parents, officials, coaches and all members of the Papertown Pinner staff is expected at all times.
3. Coaches may not subject any wrestler to forms of illegal weight loss methods such as water repellents, laxatives, etc.
4. Threatening language, roughness, or physically handling a wrestler other than to demonstrate technique will not be tolerated.

COACHING GUIDELINES

1. Coaches are requested to attend any meetings and training sessions that occur during the season.
2. All coaches shall attend matches properly attired.
3. Coaches shall attempt to know the limitations of each wrestler and avoid pushing them beyond their physical capabilities.
4. When offering criticism, coaches are asked to do so in a constructive manner so that the wrestler is aware of his mistake and how to correct it.
5. Coaches are asked to keep in mind that the purpose of this program is not to train professionals, but to familiarize participants with the sport of wrestling, to help develop skills at all levels, to promote sportsmanship, and most of all to have fun.

I acknowledge that I have read and agree to abide by the coaches conduct as well as the listed guidelines.

I understand that I may have my coaching privileges revoked and be dismissed from further participation with the Papertown Pinner organization based upon the recommendation of the board.
