Applicants must successfully complete each phase & step in order to remain eligible to continue in the process.

Phase 1 - Pre-Offer

Step 1 - Application

- A. Online Application Anyone seeking employment with the Department as a dispatcher must complete and submit an application for employment via Frederick Police Department website https://frederickpolice.org or www.governmentjobs.com
- B. Application Screening Once the application is received, it will be reviewed for minimum qualifications and disqualifiers
- C. PHQ You will also be emailed a Personal History Questionnaire (PHQ) to complete

Step 2 - Practical Exercise/Test

Applicant will then be scheduled for a practical exercise/test

Step 3 – Interview

Applicant will be interviewed by a board consisting of Departmental members

Step 4 – Background Investigation

Applicant will meet with a Background Investigator for an interview and any necessary follow-up interviews Applicant will provide the required documents to the investigator for review, authentication, & verification Applicant will provide completed and notarized Personal History Questionnaire (PHQ) to Background Investigator at this time

Step 5 – Polygraph Examination

Applicants in the background stage of the selection process are required to submit to a polygraph examination and will be contacted by polygraph examiner to schedule polygraph

Phase 2 - Post-Offer

Step 6 - Medical Examination

Information will be provided to applicants who advance to this stage of the process

Step 7 – Drug Screening

Information will be provided to applicants who advance to this stage of the process
