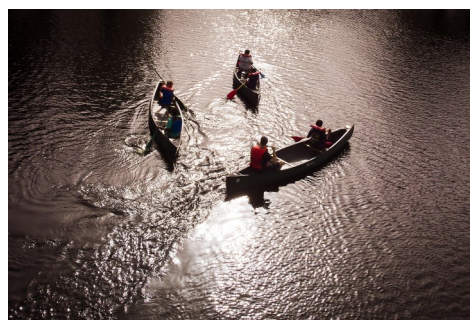
2020 Camp Hope Internship

Established in 1996, Camp Hope was the first camp for children living with HIV/AIDS in Texas. Through traditional camp activities, Camp Hope provides kids ages seven to 16 from marginalized or underserved households the opportunity to develop important life skills needed to manage a life with HIV/AIDS in a healthy and secure environment.

New in 2020! Siblings of campers living with HIV will be invited to camp, and 17-year-old camp graduates are invited back to participate in our inaugural Teen Leadership Institute, *Grown-ish!* The goal of *Grown-ish* is to help campers prepare for the next steps after high school.

Responsibilities:

- Oversee vital projects necessary to hosting a safe and enriching camp experience
- Compile and maintain the Camp Hope roster.
- Create a project timeline and procure necessary supplies
- Administer Camp Hope outcome surveys, and present on results
