STUDENT COMMITMENT

Students involved in the Zoo Teen Program are expected to follow the same guidelines as Zoo employees. If selected, Zoo Teens are required to report to their assignment on their scheduled days. A typical day is from 9am to 4pm with a hour lunch, but the schedule may vary based on the needs of the specific assignment, daily programming and staffing. In the case of an absence, it is the responsibility of the Zoo Teen to contact the Coordinator of their absence.
