We will need to move quickly through the builds and getting dogs to the line on time to help keep the day moving along.

Building Hours: Building will be open at **7:00am** each day. Thirty minutes after the last dog has run, everyone should be out of the building. No dogs can be left overnight in the building.

Groups: We will be assigning everyone a group for running and a group for walking. There will be 3 scheduled walks for each class which will take place before the runs. Group A will run first on Friday, Group B will run first on Saturday and Group A will run first on Sunday.

First Dog: 8:15AM

There will be a table to receive your competitor goodie bag. **NOTE: If you still owe for your online entry, you will not be allowed to run until you have paid the balance.**

Crating: There will not be crating in the main building. If you would like to crate outside your car there will be room in the barn to crate.

Food: Only water is allowed inside the arena. Please limit all other food and drink to the lobby.

No food will be available at the trial. Please plan to bring your own.

Check-in: We will be using Agility Gate for gating and check in. The code is 2030.

Maps: Maps will be posted in the arena when the trial site opens and on Darkstormservices.com website.



Site rules: All dogs must be on leash at all times, except when in the ring. Exercise and toilet your dog in designated areas, and not within 10 feet of any building. No exhibitors or dog(s) are allowed near the horses or on horse farm property. Please pick up after your dogs and use garbage containers on the site. Please be courteous to others using the area. No aggressive dogs.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement.

This is a NON-SMOKING facility inside of the building or near the doors.

No alcohol on the premises as per the rental agreement of the facility.

Bitches in Season: - May run at this show and must start on a mat provided by the exhibitor or club. In season pants may be worn at handler's own risk.

Not for Competition Runs (NFC): You may turn any run into an NFC run, but must declare this right before entering the ring. You may use any sort of toy (NO food, NO clickers). You may use this time for any type of training, as long as you are not abusive/harsh/overly corrective to your dog. You may use the SCT to train any piece of equipment multiple times. If you choose to train the start line, the time will be started once the handler begins to walk back towards the dog. You are allowed to bring an additional person in the ring as well to aid in training. You may bring training aides such as mats in ring, but they cannot be placed on the equipment. You MUST leave the ring immediately once time is up. If you run NFC in Pentathlon, you will automatically be disqualified from Finals. **NFC Max course time is 45 seconds.**

Repeat and Move On: During a run, a competitor may immediately repeat any obstacle one time at the competitor's discretion. This is an immediate elimination. In so doing, the competitor may repeat one or a maximum of two relevant preceding obstacle(s) prior to the point of error if it is beneficial to their performance of the obstacle. If the error is a knocked bar, a competitor may reset a maximum of 1 jump bar. The handler can either continue to work the remainder



of the course in normal competitive spirit or immediately head to the exit of the ring.

Entering the ring: Flat buckle collars without dangles are allowed in the ring. You may bring your toy into the ring and drop it at the start line along with your leash.

Volunteers: We can't put on a show without workers, so please consider volunteering. For Tournament classes we are running in groups. Each rotation there will be one group who is off. If you are in this group please sign up to volunteer.

Measuring Dogs: Please ensure you understand the new criteria regarding dogs being measured. UKI Rule Book edition 10: If a dog is under 3 and newly registered, a temporary measure or proof of the dog's height must be done by the dog's 3rd trial. A permanent measure must be obtained by a UKI official measurer between 12-18 months after the dog's first/ temporary measure. Any registered dog that only has a temporary measure must follow the above rule. If a newly registered dog is over 3, they must obtain a measure by an official UKI measurer by their 3rd trial and this measurement will be permanent. If you ask for a challenge measure when you have a permanent measure, you must state this when you are getting the dog measured so the correct protocol can be followed, and you may not continue to challenge a measure when you have challenged it once.
