

Notice to all Grand Traverse Internal and Family Medicine Laboratory Patients:

Some tests drawn at our Laboratory may be sent to Munson Medical Center Laboratory for testing.

Grand Traverse Internal and Family Medicine (GTIFM) Laboratory is a CLIA accredited Moderate Complexity Physician's Office Lab.

Many diagnostic laboratory tests that are permitted under the moderate complexity accreditation are offered to patients of our clinic and other physicians with a valid medical license. Not all lab orders can be performed and billed by GTIFM Laboratory. Examples of these tests include:

- Certain high complexity lab tests cannot be performed at GTIFM Laboratory as defined by CLIA regulations
- Tests ordered by your physician may not be offered on the GTIFM Laboratory test menu. GTIFM Laboratory's Technical Supervisor and Laboratory Director routinely evaluate the test menu to provide accurate testing for high quality patient care. The test menu offered may change periodically due to supply, staffing, physician need and financial events.
- Certain insurances exclude CPT codes from the test menu in their contract.
 - Examples of these insurances include (but are not limited to):
Blue Cross Michigan and Medicare Plus Blue
 - Examples of the excluded CPT codes include (but are not limited to):
84153-PSA 82306- Vitamin D

Testing not done at GTIFM Laboratory due to the complexity level of the test, test menu exclusion, insurance restrictions and unforeseen instrument problems or supply chain delays may be drawn at GTIFM Laboratory and couriered to Munson Medical Center for testing.

Munson Medical Center's Laboratory is the reference laboratory for GTIFM Laboratory.

Tests performed at GTIFM Laboratory will be billed by Grand Traverse Internal and Family Medicine, PC.

Tests sent to Munson Medical Center Laboratory for testing will be billed by Munson Medical Center.
