

7:30am – gates open to competitors.

8:00am – 8:55am – course walk - unmounted, hand-walking only

9:00am - Competitor meeting at check-in booth

9:15am – 9:45am – course walk - unmounted, hand-walking only

9:55am – GATES CLOSE (no entry after this time)

10:00am - Competition begins

## **UPON ARRIVAL:**

- 1. ENTER THROUGH GATES and check in with the following info:
  - a. Rider's name
  - b. Horse's coggins test, rabies certificate, vaccination record, and waivers (if not already complete)

## **AFTER PARKING:**

- 1. Prep your horse and immediately proceed to the Rigging and Shoe check with:
  - a. signed waiver (if necessary)
  - b. horse in proper footgear (studded shoes or boots required on fronts)
  - c. saddle with proper rigging
  - d. skier
- 2. After shoes and rigging have been approved, you will receive your race packet.

Competitors will run in order of registration; we are NOT running in divisions this year.

## **DURING EVENT:**

- All competitors in order of initial registration will take their first run (we are not running in separate divisions this year).
- When the entire field is finished, each participant will then take their second run.
- Divisions will NOT run separately entries will run in order of registration
- Competitors have two runs and will receive the score of their best run.

## WHILE COMPETING:

- 1. Riders will run in listed order.
- 2. Please pay attention and be ready at least <u>five</u> numbers before your own, as some numbers are absent.
  - a. When you are "up", you will be at the starting area getting hooked up.
  - b. When you are "on deck", you will be on the track behind the starting line.
  - c. When you are "in the hole," you will be waiting with your horse and skier by the check in booth
- 3. If you miss being up, on deck, or in the hole, your run will automatically be moved to the end of the order.
- 4. If your horse has difficulty getting hooked to the rigging, you may be asked to move your place in line.
