




Magic Ring

Instructions Sheet



1. Begin by holding the Magic Ring with the mesh side up and the ring below. BE CAREFUL. Each ring is hand welded and polished. There may be some sharp edges



2. Locate the four points shown on the Magic Ring . These are the 4 points you will begin inserting foliage or floral stems. Place the first stem in position 1 and rotate clockwise and insert the send stem. Be sure to cross the stem to the outside



 Continue placing stems in the remaining two holes. Using a piece of bind wire or a small cable tie (zip tie) secure the stems.
Be sure the stems are centered below the ring.



4. Continue to add additional stems moving clockwise around the outer edge of the ring. It is important that the stems remain to the outside as they cross the bind area. This will ensure the bouquet will maintain a spiral look. Once the outer ring has been filled with stems (we suggest a total of 12 stems to begin with). Add a few additional stems in the center and bind all the stems at the center over the top of the first bind.

Note: Once you have bound the stems, you can set the bouquet down and pick it up without your stems shifting!

For an organic look, the ring may be sprayed with adhesive and dipped in finely ground deer moss.



5. Fill the ring to the desired amount of foliage. It is very important to not overfill the Magic Ring. You will want space to place floral stems into the ring. Position the stems until you are satisfied with the overall shape of the foliage. Now begin placing floral stems in to the ring. Place the stems to the outside of the center bind point. Turn the ring counter clockwise and you make insertions. Once all florals have been added, you can add additional foliage as



6. After floral stems have been inserted, adjust the flowers and foliage to the desired shape and size. Bind once again at the center point. Use a cable tie if you are placing your bouquet in a vase. If used as a hand held bouquet, bind using 1/2" waterproof floral tape. Finish the stems with ribbon or other desired method to complete your bouquet. The Magic Ring is so simple to use, even a beginner will look like a seasoned professional.
