Meet Our Speakers!



Dr. Louis G. Portugal graduated in 1987 from the University of Missouri-Kansas City 6-year Medical Program. He completed his residency in Otolaryngology at University of Illinois in 1992, followed by a fellowship in Head and Neck Oncologic Surgery at the University of Cincinnati in 1993. He has been in academic medicine for 25 years having trained over 100 residents in his specialty. Among the numerous positions that he has held, he has been Medical Director of the University of Illinois Eye & Ear Infirmary, Director of Head & Neck Surgery at Loyola University Cancer Center and President of the Chicago ENT Society. For the last 12 years, he has been at the University of Chicago where he is currently a Professor of Surgery. Dr. Portugal's primary clinical interest is in otolaryngology (ENT), specifically in the field of head and neck oncologic surgery. He has been recently recognized by Chicago Magazine as one of the Top Cancer Doctors in the greater Chicagoland area, running a very busy tertiary practice as part of the prestigious University of Chicago Cancer Center. Dr. Portugal is also a well-known author and educator with a particular interest in the subject of quality improvement in healthcare.

Tracy Clark has over 30 years of varied nursing and health care experience. Tracy holds a masters of Nursing Degree with a focus on Leadership and Administration from Walden University, a Bachelor of Nursing from Malone University, and a Nursing Diploma from Idabelle Firestone School of Nursing. While her clinical expertise is critical care, she has served in multiple nursing leadership roles from a clinical manager to administration. In these roles, she has been responsible and successful in leadership, management, surgical step down units, stroke unit and a pediatric unit. She has served as the Joint Commission Coordinator for a large healthcare institute where she was responsible for all aspects of the survey and post survey process for Hospital, Home Care, Long Term Care and DME as well as Stroke Certification. She has also served as a Director of Quality Improvement at a local hospital. Before her position at GOJO, Tracy served as Director of Clinical Transformation. She went on later to become a physician strategist and consultant for one of the largest electronic medical record companies in the US. She has also presented electronic medical record implementation strategies, as well as, methods to increase compliance at an international conference.



Dr. William Jarvis is the founder and President of a private consultant company in healthcare epidemiology, infectious diseases and epidemiology. He is also Chairman of the Food and Drug Administration's General Hospital and Personal-use Committee. Over the years, he has been the recipient of numerous awards, including the CDC's Lifetime Achievement Award and the CDC's Lifetime Achievement Award in Epidemiology. He has over 400 peer-reviewed publications and has edited five books, including the latest edition (6th edition) of the book, Hospital Infections. Dr. Jarvis has published his work in many periodicals, including the CDC's Morbidity and Mortality Weekly Report, the Journal of the American Medical Association (JAMA), the New England Journal of Medicine (NEJM), the Lancet, the Journal of Infectious Disease (JID), and Clinical Infectious Diseases (CID), among others.

Patricia Gould, RN received her education from National Park College and Grand Canyon University and is currently the Senior Infection Preventionist at CHI St. Vincent. She is a registered nurse with 13 years of infectious disease experience. Patricia was past president of APIC 46 and received an award from Arkansas Foundation for Medical Care in 2014 for her work with *Clostridium difficile* reduction.
