## **Treatment Options for Erectile Dysfunction**

Erection is achieved by 90%-95% of men erosion (tissue around the implant may break down) requiring activating a pump which pushes fluid into the penis. Satisfaction rates removal, mechanical failure leading to re-operation and The pump and reservoir are implanted in the testis. with the prosthesis removal. Prosthesis placement destroys the tissue that are very high. normally fills during a spontaneous erection. So, prosthesis placement is considered permanent.

## **Corewave Low Intensity Shock Wave Therapy**

The mechanism of action involves angiogenesis, and is best suited for patients with vasculogenic ED .Corewave therapy is painless and takes about 20 min per session for 6-8 weeks.

 Potential to reduce the need for oral ED medications.



- Unlikely to help men with neurogenic ED
- Treatment is not covered by insurance and costs \$2,400 for a complete treatment protocol.
- This is an off-label use of the technology. There are no reports of complications in the literature but theoretically could cause fibrosis or hematoma of the penis.
