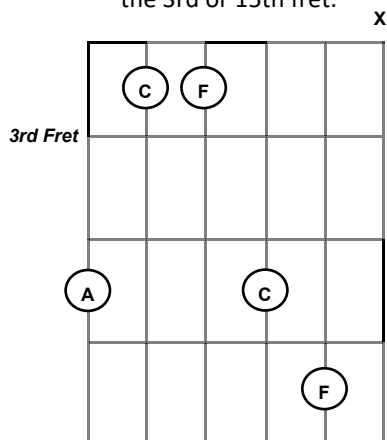


The **E Major** chord is played without the 1st string. This is represented by the "X." The **E Major** can be played on either the 2nd or 14th fret. When we slide the **E Major** up the neck of the guitar, it changes names. See illustrations below.

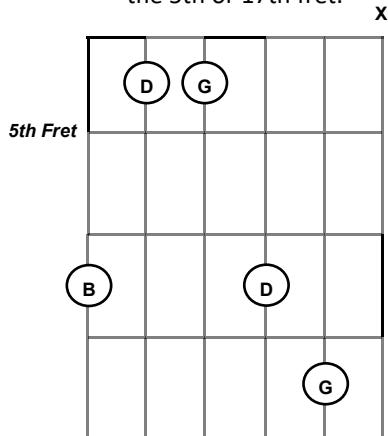
### F Major

Can be played on either the 3rd or 15th fret.



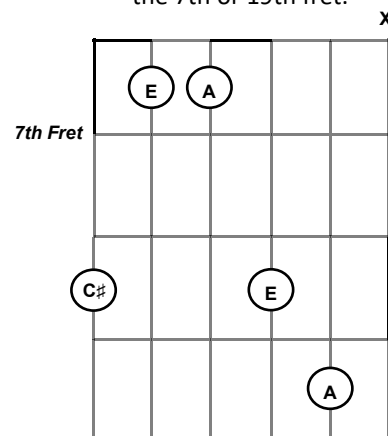
### G Major

Can be played on either the 5th or 17th fret.



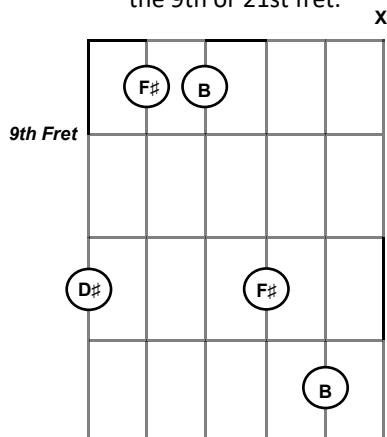
### A Major

Can be played on either the 7th or 19th fret.

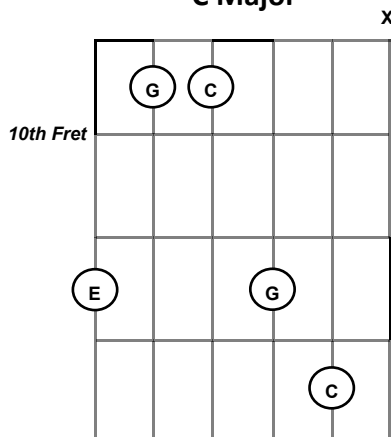


### B Major
