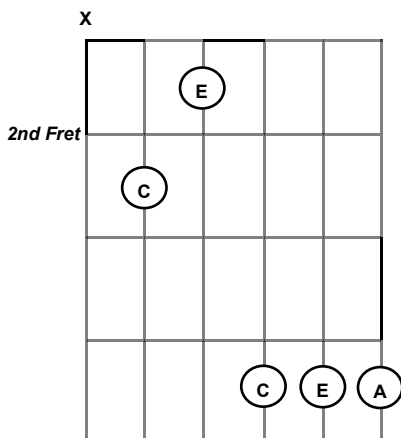


The **G minor** chord is played without the 5th and 6th strings. This is represented by the "X." The **G minor** can also be played on the 12th fret, using the same configuration as the chords shown below. When we slide the **G minor** up the neck of the guitar, it changes names.

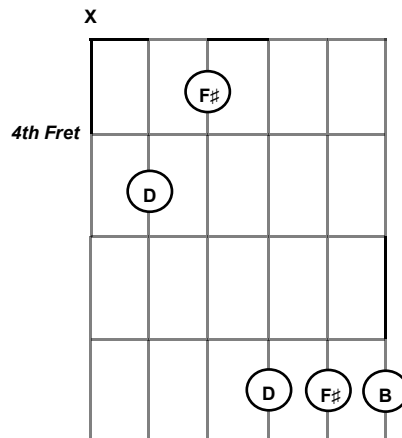
A minor

Can be played on either the 2nd or 14th fret.



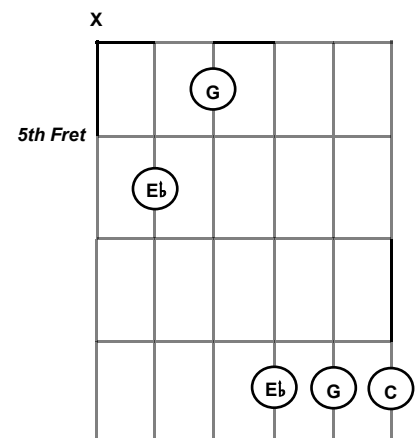
B minor

Can be played on either the 4th or 16th fret.



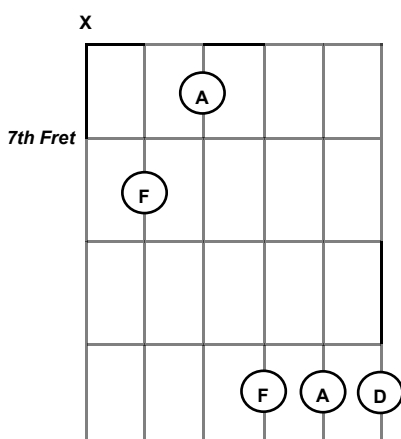
C minor

Can be played on either the 5th or 17th fret.

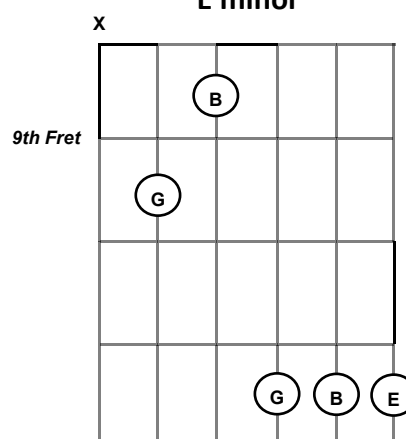


D minor
