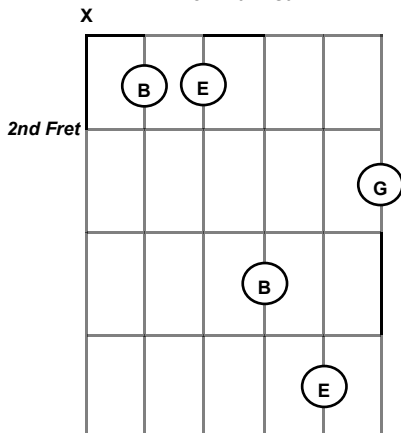


The **D minor** chord is played without the 6th string. This is represented by the "X." The **D minor** can also be played on the 12 fret using the same configuration as the chords below. When we slide the **D minor** up the neck of the guitar, it changes names.

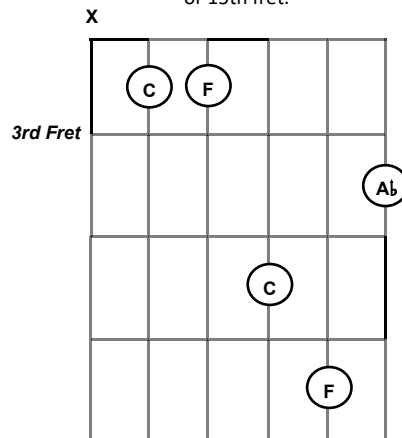
### E minor

Can be played on either the 2nd or 14th fret.



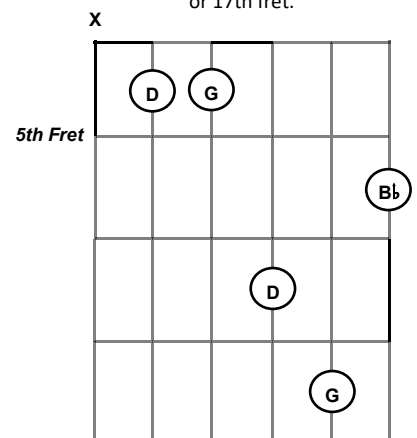
### F minor

Can be played on either the 3rd or 15th fret.



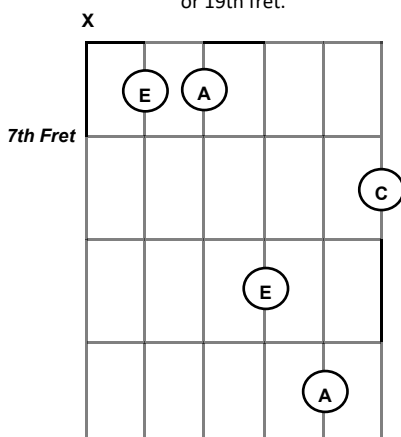
### G minor

Can be played on either the 5th or 17th fret.



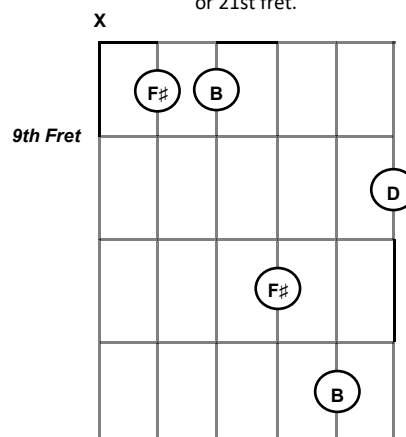
### A minor

Can be played on either the 7th or 19th fret.



### B minor

Can be played on either the 9th or 21st fret.



### C minor
