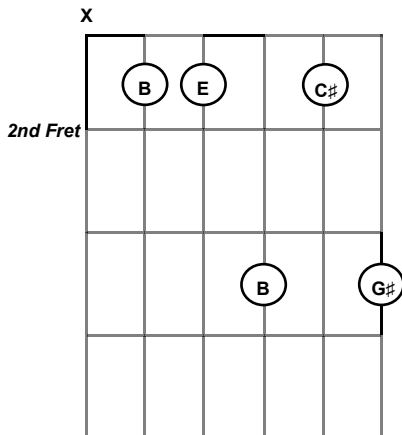


The **D6** chord is played without the 6th string. This is represented by the "X." When we play the **D6** on the 12th fret, we play it as a barre chord. We use the same configuration as the barre chords shown below. When we slide the **D6** up the neck of the guitar, it changes names.

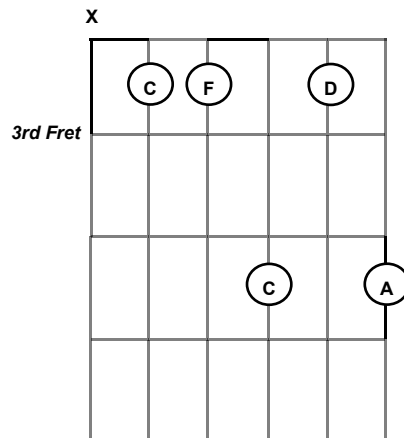

Can be played on either the 2nd or 14th fret.



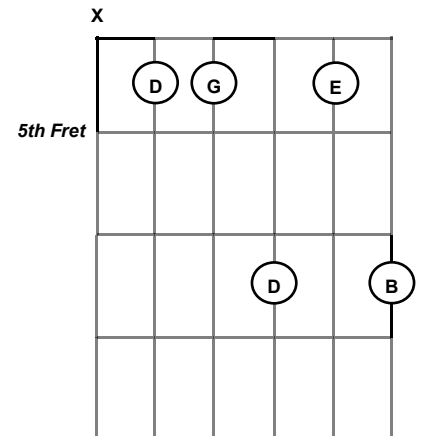

Can be played on either the 3rd or 15th fret.



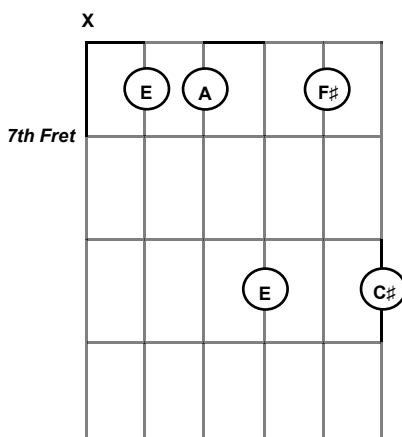
G6

Can be played on either the 5th or 17th fret.

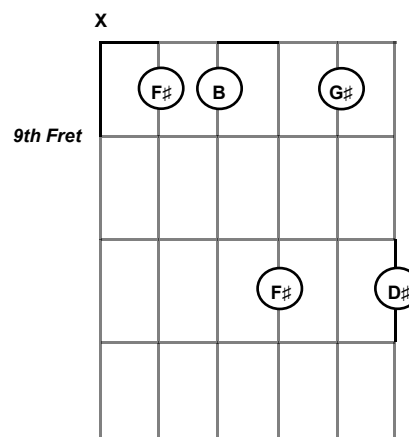
