



The **D7** chord is played without the 6th string. This is represented by the "X." When we play the **D7** chord on the 12th fret, we play it without the 5th and 6th strings. We use the same configuration as the chords shown below. When we slide the **D7** up the neck of the guitar, it changes names.


E7Can be played on either the 2nd or 14th fret.




F7Can be played on either the 3rd or 15th fret.




G7Can be played on either the 5th or 17th fret.
