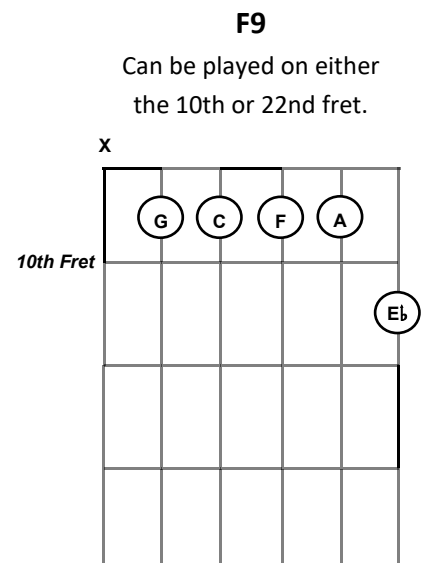
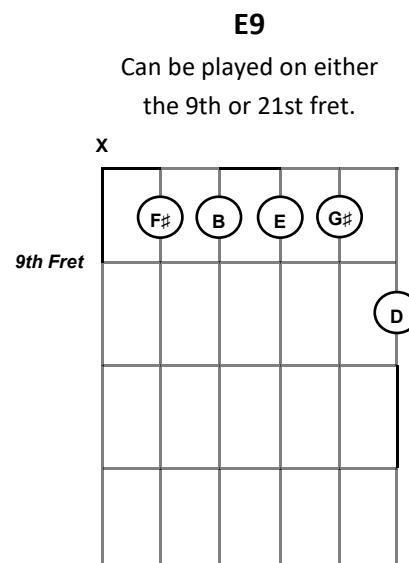
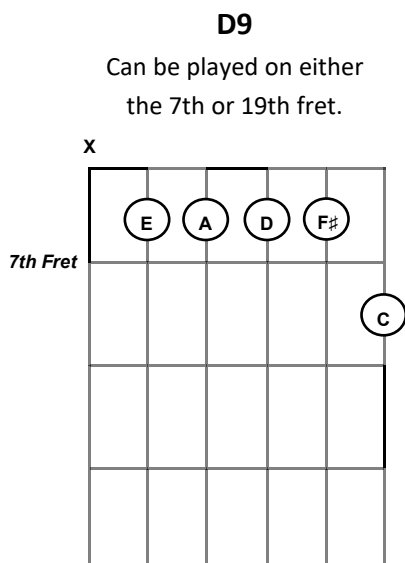
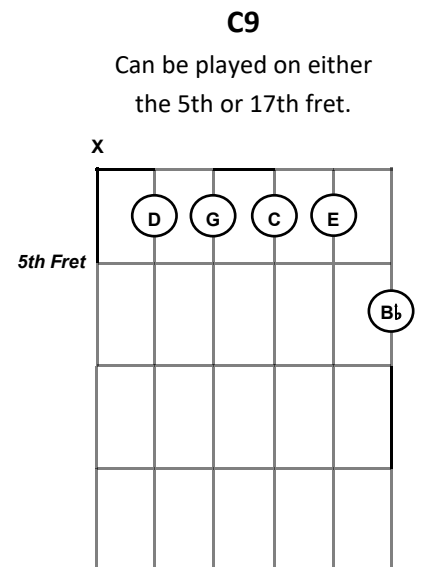
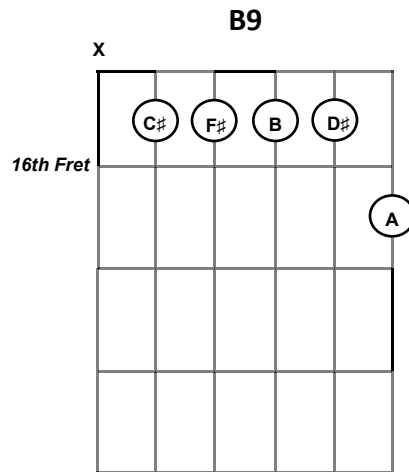
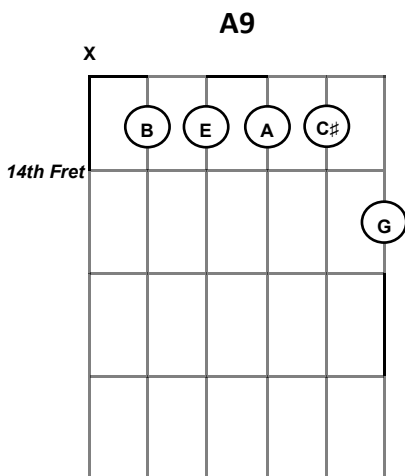


The **G9** chord is played without the 6th string. This is represented by "X." When we play the **G9** chord on the 12th fret, we play it as a barre chord. We use the same configuration as the barre chords below. When we slide the **G9** up the neck of the guitar, it changes names.
