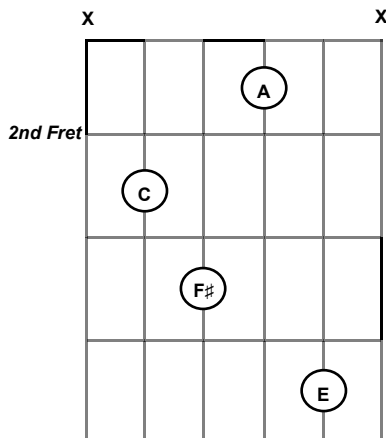


The **Gm6** chord is displayed to the left. It is played without the 6th string. This is represented by "X." When we play the **Gm6** chord on the 12th fret, it is played without the 1st and 6th strings. We use the same configuration as the chords shown below. When we slide the **Gm6** up the neck of the guitar, it changes names.

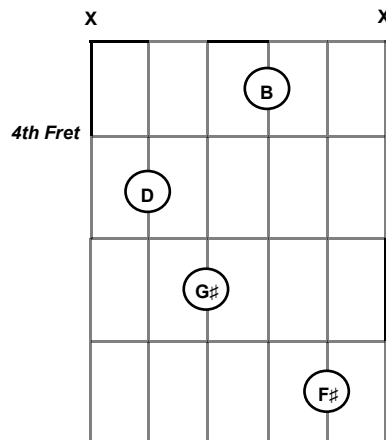
### Am6

Can be played on either the 2nd or 14th fret



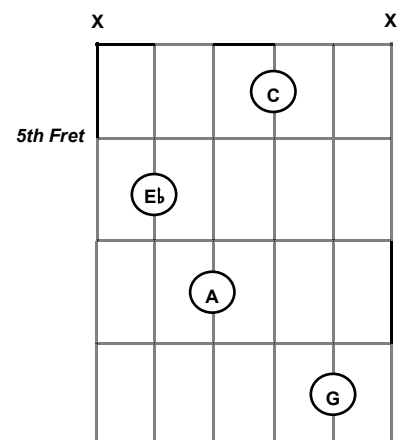
### Bm6

Can be played on either the 4th or 16th fret



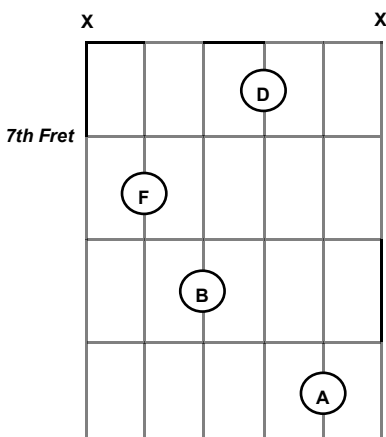
### Cm6

Can be played on either the 5th or 17th fret

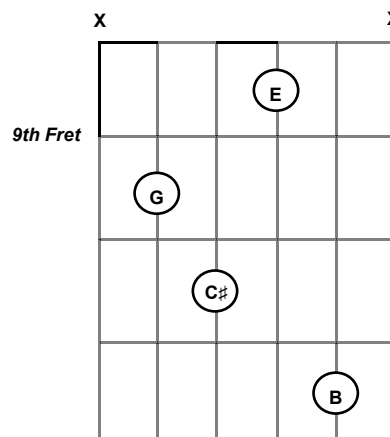


### Dm6
