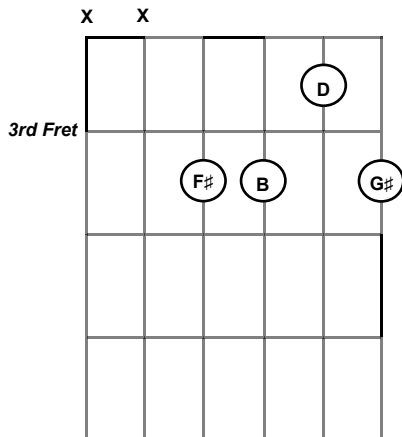


The **Am6** chord is displayed to the left. It is played without the 6th string. This is represented by "X." When we play the **Am6** chord on the 13th fret, it is played without the 5th and 6th strings. We use the same configuration as the chords shown below. When we slide the **Am6** up the neck of the guitar, it changes names.

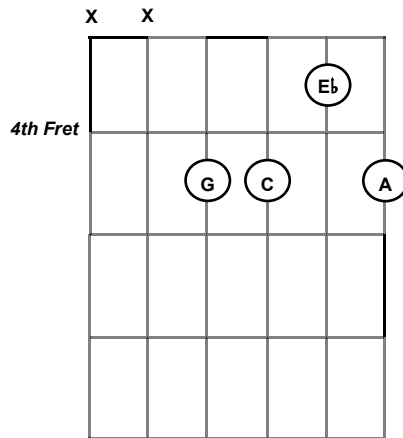
Bm6

Can be played on either the 3rd or 15th fret



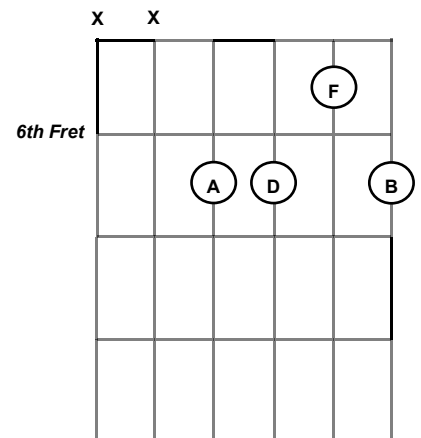
Cm6

Can be played on either the 4th or 16th fret



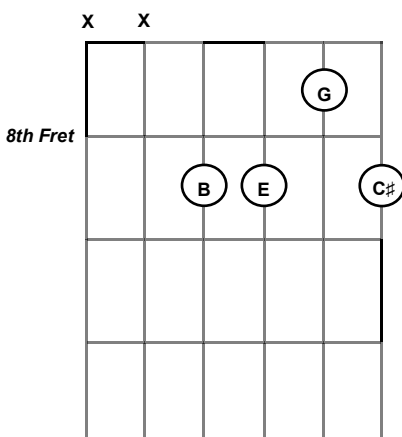
Dm6

Can be played on either the 6th or 18th fret



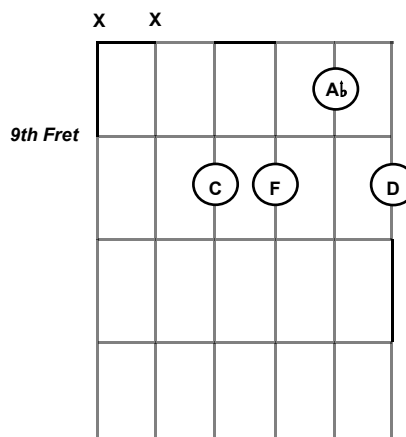
Em6
