


The **Dm7** chord is displayed to the left. It is played without the 5th and 6th strings. This is represented by "X." When we play the **Dm7** chord on the 12th fret, we use the same configuration as the chords below. When we slide the **Dm7** up the neck of the guitar, it changes names.


Em7

Can be played on either the 2nd or 14th fret.




Fm7

Can be played on either the 3rd or 15th fret.




Gm7

Can be played on either the 5th or 17th fret.




Am7

Can be played on either the 7th or 19th fret.

Can be played on either the 9th or 21st fret.
