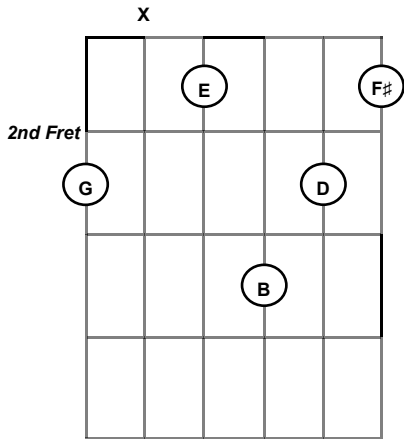


The **Dm9** chord is played without the 5th string. This is represented by "X." When we play the **Dm9** on the 12th fret, we use the same configuration as the chords shown below. When we slide the **Dm9** up the neck of the guitar, it changes names.

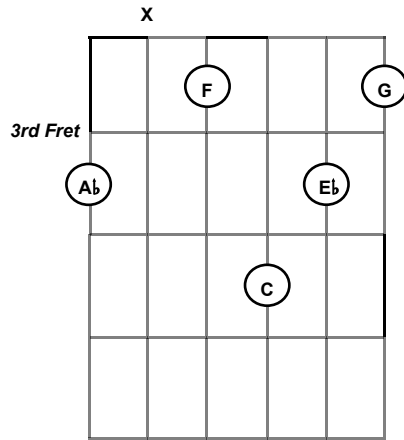
### Em9

Can be played on either the 2nd or 14th fret.



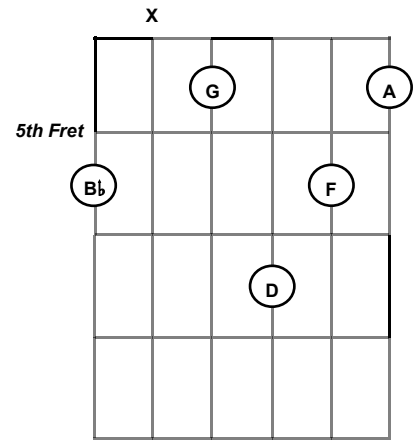
### Fm9

Can be played on either the 3rd or 15th fret.



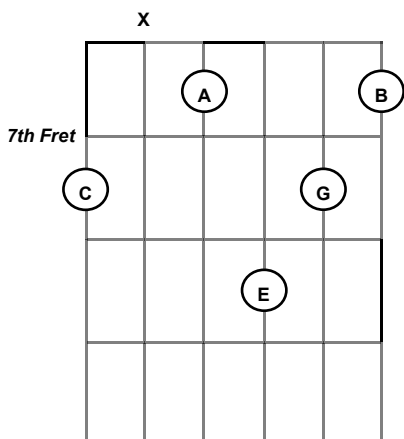
### Gm9

Can be played on either the 5th or 17th fret.



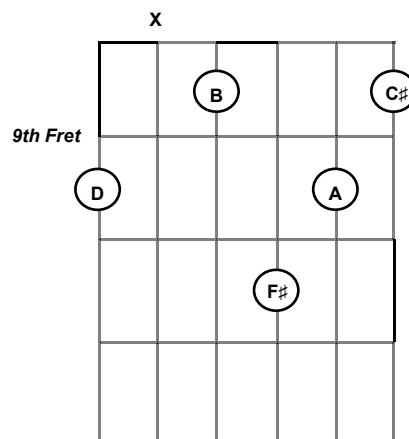
### Am9

Can be played on either the 7th or 19th fret.



### Bm9

Can be played on either the 9th or 21st fret.



### Cm9
