

The Cm7 $\frac{1}{5}$ 5 chord can be played on either the 1st or 13th fret. It is played without the 6th string. This is represented by "X." When we slide the Cm7 $\frac{1}{5}$ 5 up the neck of the guitar, it changes names.






Fm7**b**5

Can be played on either the 6th or 18th fret.




Gm7**b5**
