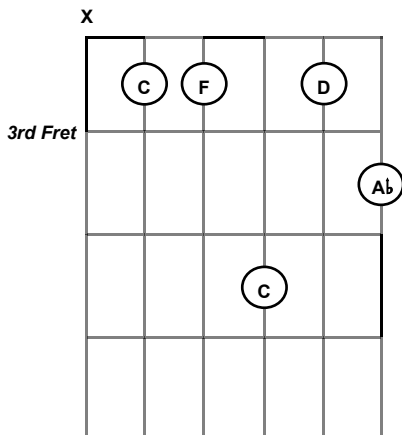


The Cm7 $\flat$ 5 chord can be played on either the 1st or 13th fret. It is played without the 6th string. This is represented by "X." When we slide the Cm7 $\flat$ 5 up the neck of the guitar, it changes names.

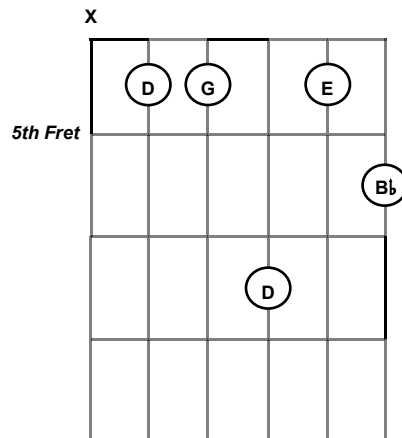
### Dm7 $\flat$ 5

Can be played on either the 3rd or 15th fret.



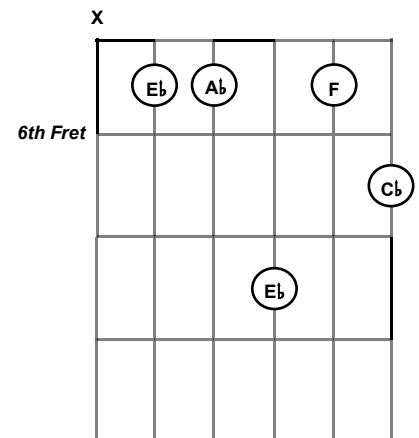
### Em7 $\flat$ 5

Can be played on either the 5th or 17th fret.



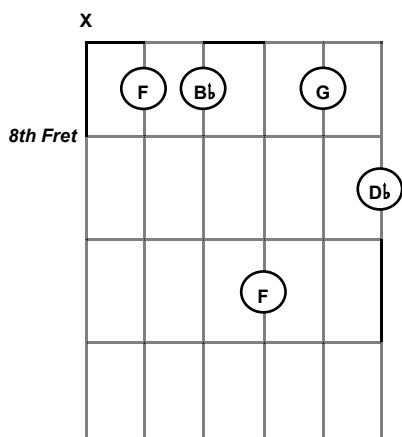
### Fm7 $\flat$ 5

Can be played on either the 6th or 18th fret.

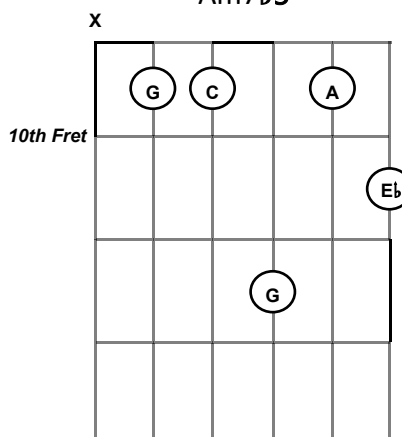


### Gm7 $\flat$ 5
