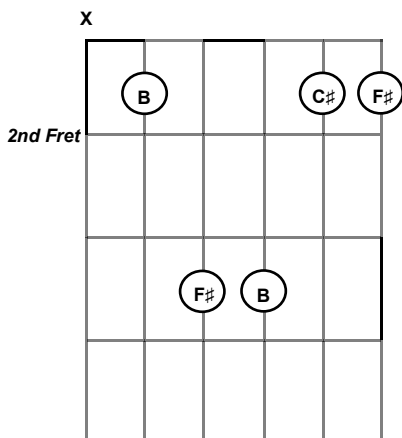


The **Asus2** chord is played without the 6th string. This is represented by "X". When we play the **Asus2** on the 12th fret, it is played as a barre chord. We use the same configuration as the barre chords shown below. When we slide the **Asus2** up the neck of the guitar, it changes names.

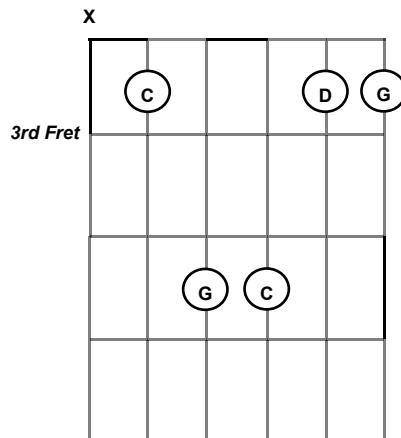
### Bsus2

Can be played on either the 2nd or 14th fret.



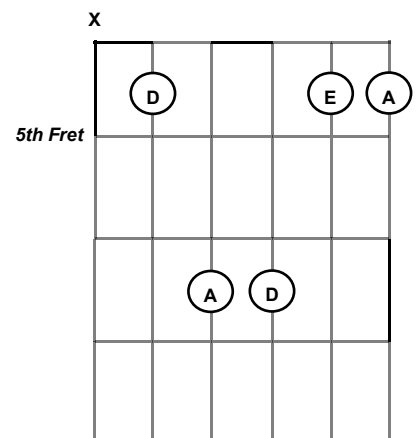
### Csus2

Can be played on either the 3rd or 15th fret.



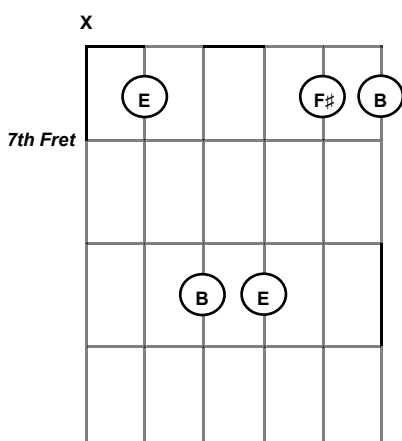
### Dsus2

Can be played on either the 5th or 17th fret.



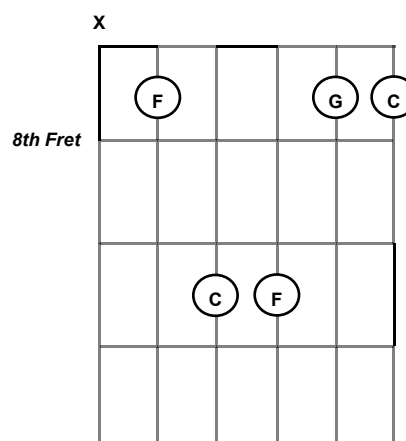
### Esus2

Can be played on either the 7th or 19th fret.
