


The **Dadd9** chord is played without the 5th string. This is represented by "X". When we play the **Dadd9** on the 12th fret, it is played as a barre chord. We use the same configuration as the barre chords shown below. When we slide the **Dadd9** up the neck of the guitar, it changes names.


### Eadd9

Can be played on either the 2nd or 14th fret.




#### Fadd9

Can be played on either the 3rd or 15th fret.




# Gadd9

Can be played on either the 5th or 17th fret.




#### Aadd9

Can be played on either the 7th or 19th fret.



#### Badd9

Can be played on either the 9th or 21th fret.
