


The **Aadd9** chord is played without the 6th string. This is represented by "X". When we play the **Aadd9** on the 12th fret, it is played as a barre chord. We use the same configuration as the barre chords shown below. When we slide the **Aadd9** up the neck of the guitar, it changes names.


Badd9

Can be played on either the 2nd or 14th fret.




Cadd9

Can be played on either the 3rd or 15th fret.




Dadd9

Can be played on either the 5th or 17th fret.




Eadd9
