


The B $\$ 5 chord can be played on either the 1st or 13th fret. It is played without the 5th and 6th strings. This is represented by "X". When we slide the B $\$ 5 up the neck of the guitar, it changes names.


Cb5

Can be played on either the 2nd or 14th fret.




Db5

Can be played on either the 4th or 16th fret.




Eb5

Can be played on either the 6th or 18th fret.




Fb5
