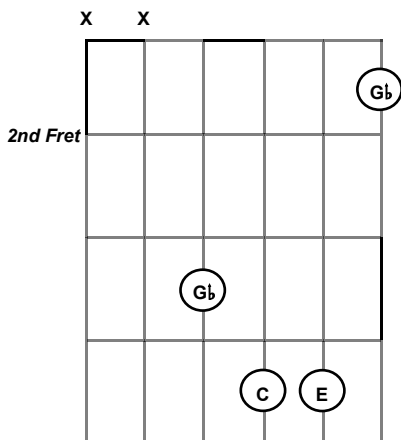


The $B\flat 5$ chord can be played on either the 1st or 13th fret. It is played without the 5th and 6th strings. This is represented by "X". When we slide the $B\flat 5$ up the neck of the guitar, it changes names.

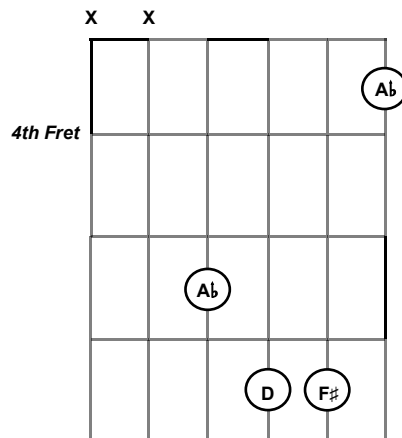
$C\flat 5$

Can be played on either the 2nd or 14th fret.



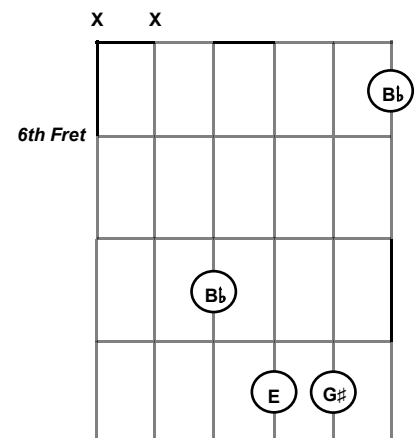
$D\flat 5$

Can be played on either the 4th or 16th fret.



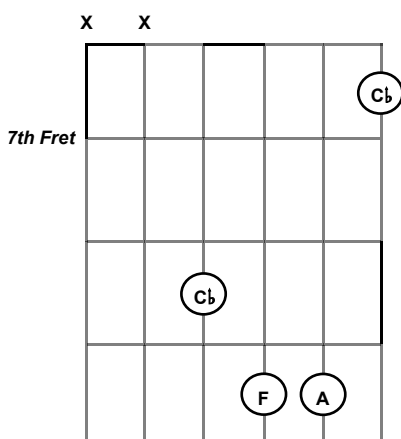
$E\flat 5$

Can be played on either the 6th or 18th fret.



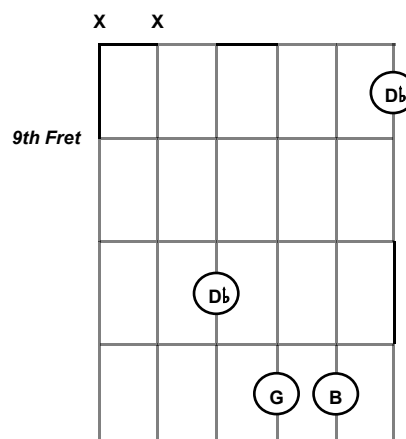
$F\flat 5$
