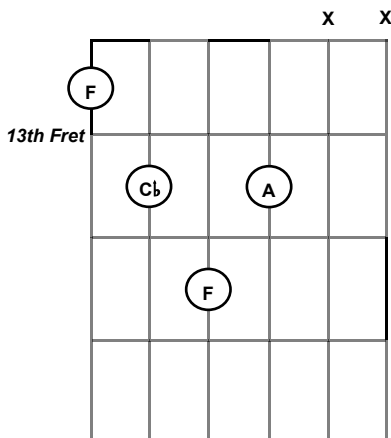


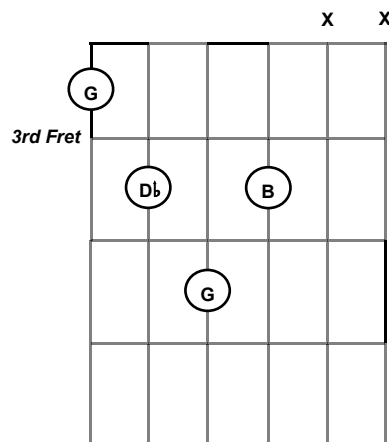
The $E\flat 5$ chord is played without the 1st and 2nd strings. This is represented by "X." When we play the $E\flat 5$ on the 12th fret, we use the same configuration as the chords shown below. When we slide the $E\flat 5$ up the neck of the guitar, it changes names.

$F\flat 5$



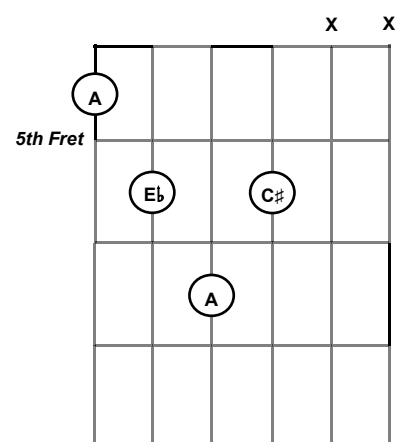
$G\flat 5$

Can be played on either the 3rd or 15th fret.



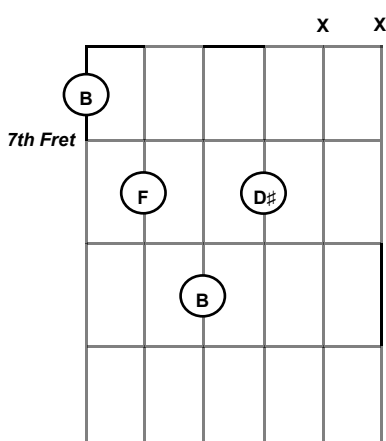
$A\flat 5$

Can be played on either the 5th or 17th fret.



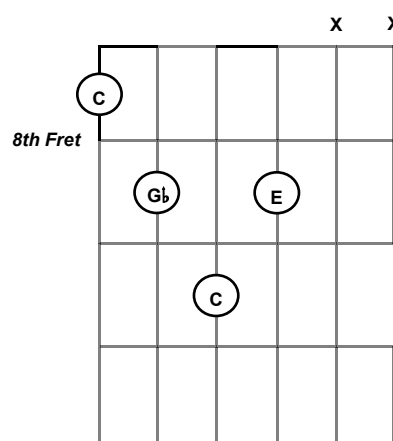
$B\flat 5$

Can be played on either the 7th or 19th fret.

Can be played on either the 8th or 20th fret.



$D\flat 5$
