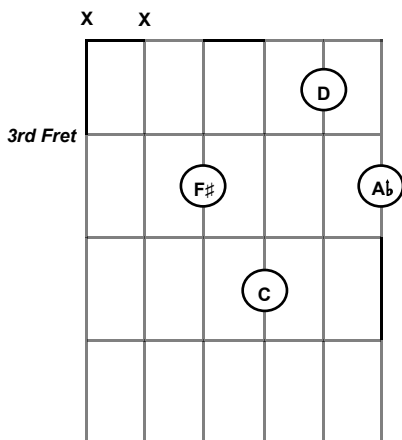


The $C7\flat 5$ chord can be played on either the 1st or 13th fret. It is played without the 5th and 6th strings. This is represented by "X". When we slide the $C7\flat 5$ up the neck of the guitar, it changes names.

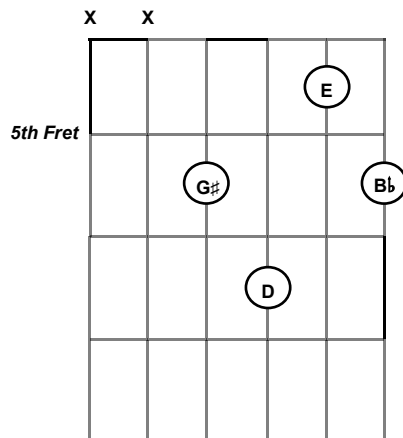
D7 $\flat 5$

Can be played on either the 3rd or 15th fret.



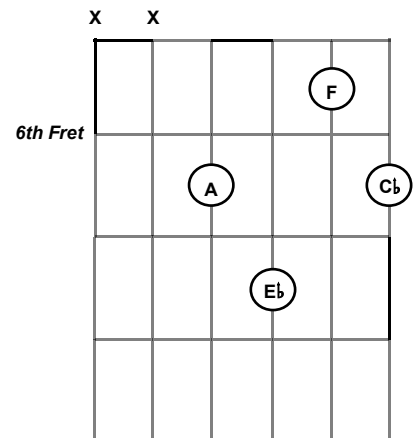
E7 $\flat 5$

Can be played on either the 5th or 17th fret.



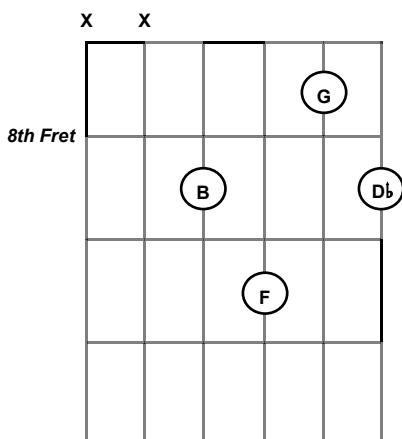
F7 $\flat 5$

Can be played on either the 6th or 18th fret.

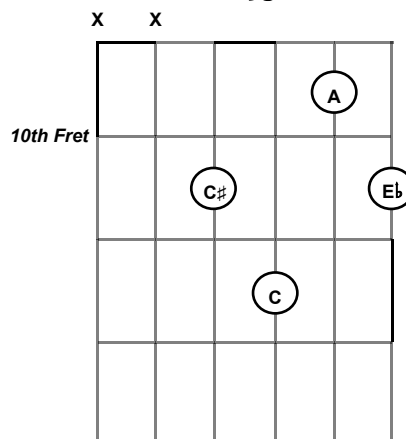


G7 $\flat 5$
