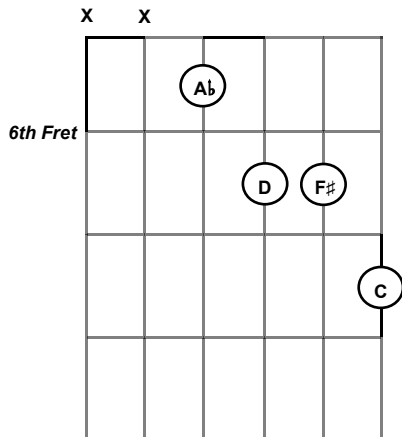


The  $C7\flat 5$  chord can be played on either the 4th or 16th fret. It is played without the 5th and 6th strings. This is represented by "X". When we slide the  $C7\flat 5$  up the neck of the guitar, it changes names.

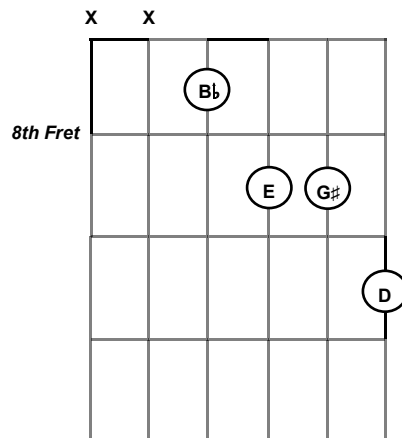
### D7 $\flat 5$

Can be played on either the 6th or 18th fret.



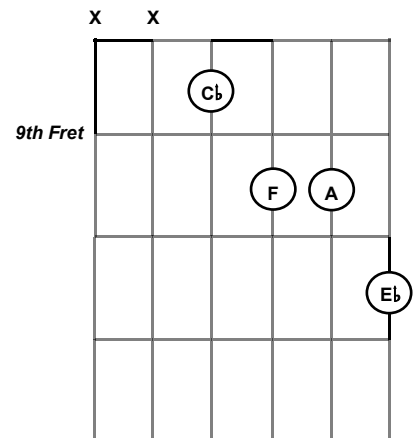
### E7 $\flat 5$

Can be played on either the 8th or 20th fret.

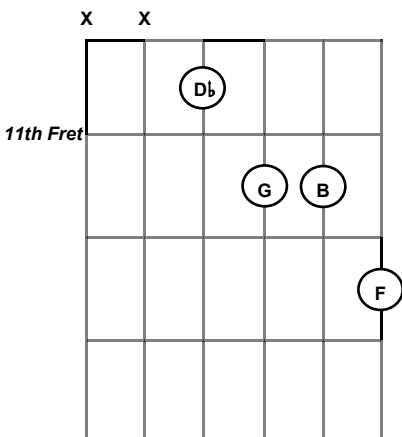


### F7 $\flat 5$

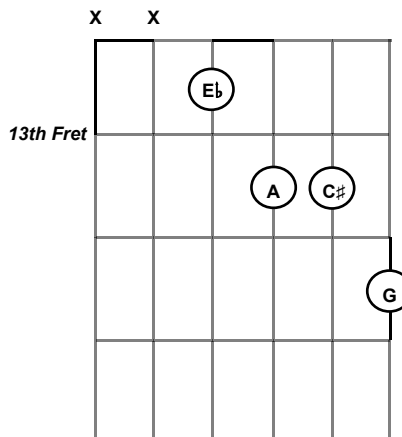
Can be played on either the 9th or 21st fret.
