


The E7 \flat 5 chord is played without the 1st and 2nd strings. This is represented by "X." When we play the E7 \flat 5 on the 12th fret, we use the same configuration as the chords shown below. When we slide the E7 \flat 5 up the neck of the guitar, it changes names.


F7 \flat 5

Can be played on either the 1st or 13th fret.




G7 \flat 5

Can be played on either the 3rd or 15th fret.




A7 \flat 5

Can be played on either the 5th or 17th fret.




B7 \flat 5

Can be played on either the 7th or 19th fret.

Can be played on either the 8th or 20th fret.
