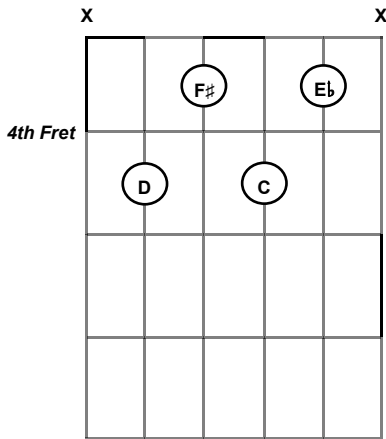


The C7**b**9 chord is played without the 6th string. This is represented by "X". When we play the C7**b**9 on the 14th fret, we play it without the 1st and 6th strings. When we slide the C7**b**9 up the neck of the guitar, it changes names.

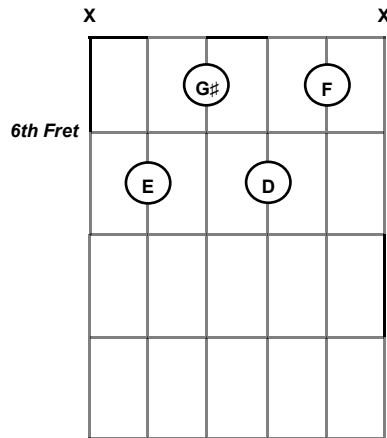
D7b**9**

Can be played on either the 4th or 16th fret.



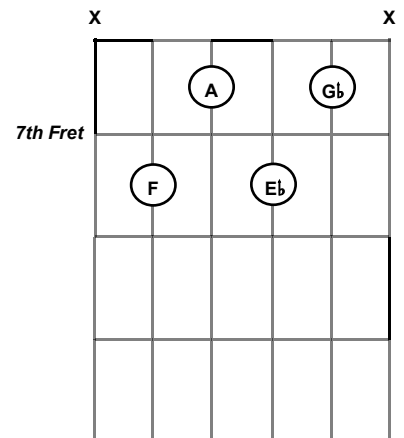
E7b**9**

Can be played on either the 6th or 18th fret.



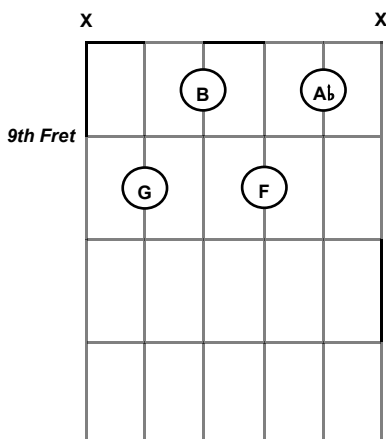
F7b**9**

Can be played on either the 7th or 19th fret.

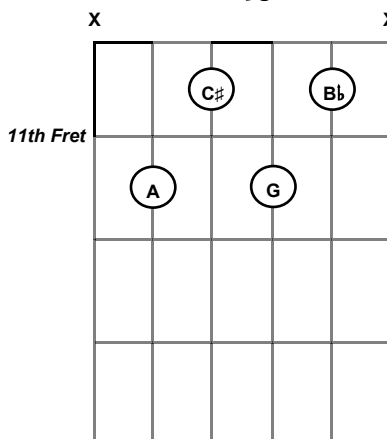


G7b**9**
