

The C7b9 chord is played without the 6th string. This is represented by "X". When we play the C7b9 on the 14th fret, we play it without the 1st and 6th strings. When we slide the C7b9 up the neck of the guitar, it changes names.


E7**b9**Can be played on either

6th Fret



Can be played on either the 7th or 19th fret.


